Why Are So Many Black Men in Prison? Demico Boothe, 2007 African American males are being imprisoned at an alarming and unprecedented rate. Out of the more than 11 million black adult males in the U S population nearly 1.5 million are in prisons and jails with another 3.5 million more on probation or parole or who have previously been on probation or parole. Black males make up the majority of the total prison population and due to either present or past incarceration is the most socially disenfranchised group of American citizens in the country today. This book which was penned by Boothe while he was still incarcerated details the author's personal story of a negligent upbringing in an impoverished community, his subsequent engagement in criminal activity, drug dealing, his incarceration and his release from prison and experiencing of the crippling social disenfranchisement that comes with being an ex felon. The author then relates his personal experiences and realizations to the seminal problems within the African American community, federal government and criminal justice system that cause his own experiences to be the same experiences of millions of other young black men. This book focuses on the totality of how and why the U S prison system became the largest prison system in the world and is filled with relevant statistical and historical references and controversial facts and quotes from notable persons and sources. **Rethinking Prison Reentry** Tony Gaskew, 2014-08-26 *Rethinking Prison Reentry: Transforming Humiliation into Humility* describes a prison based education pedagogy designed to address a prevalent racial politics of shaming, self segregation and transgenerational learned helplessness. So many incarcerated black men face insurmountable psychosocial obstacles when attempting to make the successful transition back into ownership of their lives. Tony Gaskew confronts the issue of redemption and reconciliation head on by critically examining the triads of culpability when it comes to crime and justice in America: 1 of those who commit crimes, 2 of those who enforce criminal laws and 3 of those who stand by and do nothing. He explores the growth of a black counterculture of crime that has created modern day killing fields across urban neighborhoods and challenges the incarcerated black men trapped within its socially constructed lies, helping them to draw upon the strength of their cultural privilege to transform from criminal offender into incarcerated student. **If We Must Die** Aimé J. From the Plantation to the Prison Tara T. Green, 2008 According to George Jackson black men born in the US are conditioned to accept the inevitability of being imprisoned Being born a slave in a captive society and never experiencing any objective basis for expectation had the effect of preparing me for the progressively traumatic misfortune that led so many black men to the prison gate I was prepared for prison It required only minor psychic adjustments As Jackson writes from his prison cell his statement may seem to be only a product of his current status However history proves his point Indeed some of the most well known and respected black men have served time in jail or prison Among them are Martin Luther King Jr Malcolm X Marcus Garvey and Frederick Douglass This book is an examination of the various forms that imprisonment as a social historical and political experience of African Americans has taken Confinement describes the status of individuals who are placed within boundaries either seen or unseen but always felt A word that suggests extensive implications confinement describes the status of persons who are imprisoned and who are unjustly relegated to a social status that is hostile rendering them powerless and subject to the rules of the authorities Arguably confinement appropriately describes the status of African Americans who have endured spaces of confinement which include but are not limited to plantations Jim Crow societies and prisons At specific times these spaces of confinement have been used to oppress African Americans socially politically and spiritually Contributors examine the related experiences of Malcolm X Bigger Thomas of Native Son and Angela Davis
