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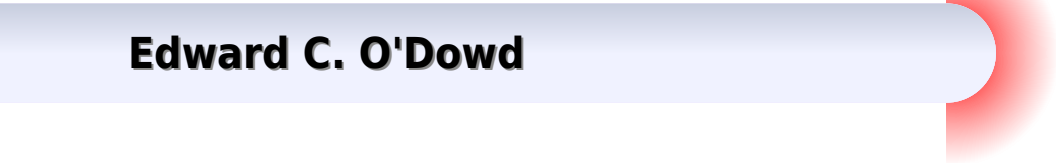

The Impact of Coincidence in Modern American, British, and Asian History Bruce A. Elleman, 2023-10-10. In 21 short case studies, this short book examines the distinctive coincidental history of America, Britain, and various Asian countries during the twentieth century. It covers a wide range of historical events, from American expansion into the Pacific to the creation of the Soviet gulags in Siberia to the end of the Vietnam War. Its main goal is to show how watershed historical events can often become layered or overlap each other, sometimes by intent but often merely by happenstance. As Ian Fleming once famously opined about actions in war: "Once is happenstance. Twice is a coincidence. Three times is enemy action."

Not Just Victims Audrey U. Kim, 2003. *Not Just Victims* contains twelve oral histories based on conversations with Cambodian community leaders in eight American cities: Long Beach, Philadelphia, Washington D.C., Seattle, Portland, Tacoma, and the Massachusetts towns of Fall River and Lowell. Unlike the dozens of autobiographies published by Cambodians that focus largely on their victimization, these narratives describe how Cambodian refugees have adapted to life in the United States. Sucheng Chan's extensive introduction provides a historical framework; she discusses the civil war, 1970-75, the bloody Khmer Rouge revolution, 1975-79, the border war during the Vietnamese occupation of Cambodia, 1979-89, and the additional travails faced by those who escaped to holding camps in Thailand. The book also includes an essay on oral history and a substantial bibliography.

The US Navy and the South China Sea Bruce A. Elleman, 2024-08-13. This book explores the question: Why is the US Navy in the South China Sea at all? It traces the history of diplomatic, economic, and military tensions among the People's Republic of China, the Soviet Union, the United States, and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, outlining the origins of the United States-Vietnam relationship during the immediate post-World War II period, the turmoil of the Vietnam War during which China supported North Vietnam against a US-backed South Vietnam, and the decision of the US government to open relations with China beginning in 1972. It shows how from 1945-1975 the US government used its relations with Vietnam to exert diplomatic, economic, and military pressure on China to open negotiations, leading to full recognition and further discusses the surprising action of the US Navy in 1974 to allow the Chinese Navy to take the Paracel Islands by force, thereby denying control over these islands to a united Vietnam closely allied with the Soviet Union, which was the common enemy of both China and the USA. Overall, the book demonstrates how the presence of the US Navy in the

South China Sea is a crucial element in much wider global US strategy **Collateral Damage** Nicholas Khoo, 2011

Although the Chinese and the Vietnamese were Cold War allies in wars against the French and the Americans their alliance collapsed and they ultimately fought a war against each other in 1979 More than thirty years later the fundamental cause of the alliance's termination remains contested among historians international relations theorists and Asian studies specialists Nicholas Khoo brings fresh perspective to this debate Using Chinese language materials released since the end of the Cold War Khoo revises existing explanations for the termination of China's alliance with Vietnam arguing that Vietnamese cooperation with China's Cold War adversary the Soviet Union was the necessary and sufficient cause for the alliance's termination He finds alternative explanations to be less persuasive These emphasize nonmaterial causes such as ideology and culture or reference issues within the Sino-Vietnamese relationship such as land and border disputes Vietnam's treatment of its ethnic Chinese minority and Vietnam's attempt to establish a sphere of influence over Cambodia and Laos Khoo also adds to the debate over the relevance of realist theory in interpreting China's international behavior during both the Cold War and post-Cold War eras While others see China as a social state driven by nonmaterial processes Khoo makes the case for viewing China as a quintessential neorealist state From this perspective the focus of neorealist theory on security threats from materially stronger powers explains China's foreign policy not only toward the Soviet Union but also in relation to its Vietnamese allies

Deng Xiaoping Alexander V. Pantsov, Steven I. Levine, 2015-04-01 Deng Xiaoping joined the Chinese Communist movement as a youth and rose in its ranks to become an important lieutenant of Mao's from the 1930s onward Two years after Mao's death in 1976 Deng became the de facto leader of the Chinese Communist Party and the prime architect of China's post-Mao reforms Abandoning the Maoist socio-economic policies he had long fervently supported he set in motion changes that would dramatically transform China's economy society and position in the world Three decades later we are living with the results China has become the second largest economy and the workshop of the world And while it is essentially a market economy socialism with Chinese characteristics Deng and his successors ensured the continuation of CCP rule by severely repressing the democratic movement and maintaining an iron grip on power When Deng died at the age of 92 in 1997 he had set China on the path it is following to this day Alexander Pantsov and Steven Levine's new biography of Deng Xiaoping does what no other biography has done based on newly discovered documents it covers his entire life from his childhood and student years to the post-Tiananmen era Thanks to unprecedented access to Russian archives containing massive files on the Chinese Communist Party the authors present a wealth of new material on Deng dating back to the 1920s In a long and extraordinary life Deng navigated one epic crisis after another Born in 1904 Deng like many Asian revolutionary leaders spent part of the 1920s in Paris where he joined the CCP in its early years He then studied in the USSR just as Stalin was establishing firm control over the Soviet communist party He played an increasingly important role in the troubled decades of the 1930s and 1940s that were marked by civil war and the Japanese invasion He was commissar of a

communist dominated area in the early 1930s loyal henchman to Mao during the Long March regional military commander in the anti Japanese war and finally a key leader in the 1946 49 revolution During Mao s quarter century rule Deng oscillated between the heights and the depths of power He was purged during the Cultural Revolution only to reemerge after Mao s death to become China s paramount leader until his own death in 1997 This objective balanced and unprecedentedly rich biography changes our understanding of one of the most important figures in modern history **The Pacific Basin since 1945** Roger C.
