The quantitative data were processed by using SPSS 20 while the qualitative ones were coded based on semantic affinity for analysis The study revealed that listening skills such as comprehending colloquial and idiomatic expressions understanding guests multifarious English accents recognizing meaning shift because of change in intonation and stress are worthwhile for THMS prospective careers in tourism and hospitality sector Effective communication with guests on the phone clear and direct speech interpretation without meaning distortion and appropriate responses to guests requests and complaints were found to be equally important speaking skills Similarly eye contact facial expressions gesture tone and pitch volume were found to be the salient non verbal communication behaviors that should comply with the communicative contexts during oral interactions The research indicated that most THMS lacked spoken production skills
