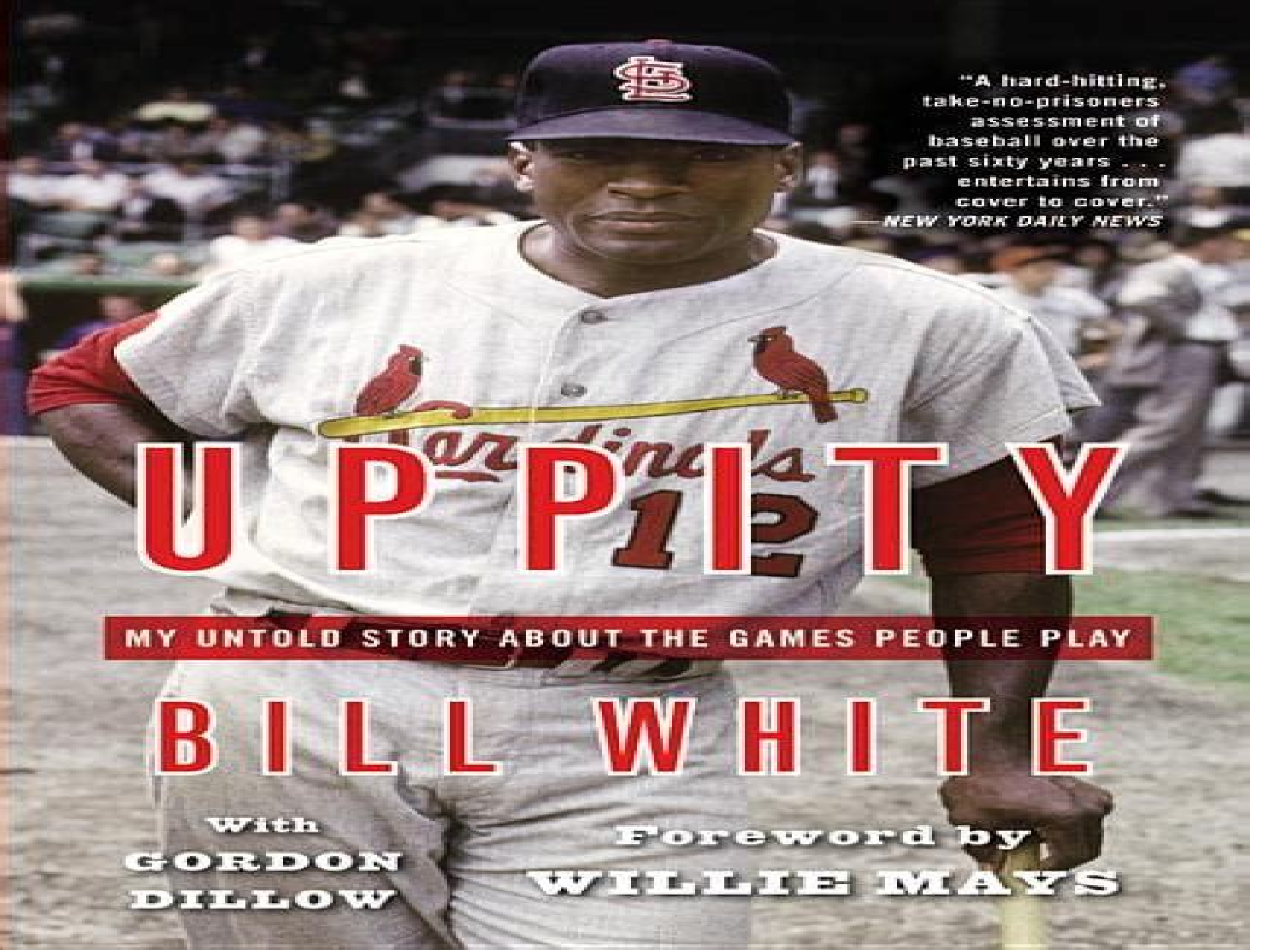

On his way to Venezuela to compete in a winter baseball league, Peete and his family died in a plane crash near Caracas. Charlie Peete's death stunned the St. Louis Cardinals and left the baseball world to forever wonder what his career might have become. But despite his premature and tragic ending, Peete changed the world for the better and left a lasting impact on the sport he spent his life pursuing.

Greatness in the Shadows Douglas M. Branson, 2016 Just weeks after Jackie Robinson joined the Brooklyn Dodgers, Larry Doby joined Robinson in breaking the color barrier in the major leagues when he became the first Black player to integrate the American League, signing with the Cleveland Indians in July 1947. Doby went on to be a seven-time All-Star center fielder who led the Indians to two pennants. In many respects, Robinson and Doby were equals in their baseball talent and experiences and had remarkably similar playing careers: both were well-educated, well-spoken World War II veterans and both had played spectacularly, albeit briefly, in the Negro Leagues. Like Robinson, Doby suffered brickbats, knock-down pitches spit in his face, and other forms of abuse and discrimination. Doby was also a pioneering manager, becoming the second Black manager after Frank Robinson. Well into the 1950s, Doby was the only African American All-Star in the American League during a period in which fifteen Black players became National League All-Stars. Why is Doby largely forgotten as a central figure in baseball's integration? Justice Batted Last Don Zminda, 2025-03-11 On May 1, 1951, Orestes Minnie Miñoso took the field for the Chicago White Sox and broke the color line for Chicago major league baseball. Ernie Banks integrated the Chicago Cubs two years later. The future Hall of Famers began their Chicago baseball careers against the backdrop of a 1951 race riot in suburban Cicero, where a white mob, abetted by local police, attacked a building that had rented to Black tenants. Jim Gilliam: The Forgotten Dodger Stephen W. Dittmore, 2025-02-04 This first full-length biography of the pioneer covers Jim Junior Gilliam's role during important baseball transitions. An established star in the Negro Leagues, Gilliam followed Jackie Robinson in MLB's integration efforts. As both a Brooklyn Dodger and Los Angeles Dodger, Gilliam notched some of the final baseball highlights at Ebbets Field and then served as a face of the new Los Angeles Dodgers. Jim Gilliam faced long odds throughout his life and had a knack for overcoming them. His father died when he was less than a year old. He was raised by his mother in segregated Nashville, Tennessee during the Great Depression, dropping out of high school to play ball. He rode buses through the Jim Crow South as a member of the Nashville Black Vols and Baltimore Elite Giants Negro Leagues teams in the 1940s. He spent two years with the Montreal Royals, the Brooklyn Dodgers' top minor league team, ostensibly because it was easier for the Dodgers to keep mediocre white talent on its big league roster than face the scrutiny of fielding a team with five Black players. He persevered to win Rookie of the Year honors as part of a long career in the majors, becoming one of MLB's first Black coaches before tragically passing away right before the 1978 World Series. On the field, Gilliam was truly the bridge between Brooklyn and Los Angeles. He recorded the last hit in Brooklyn Dodger history, scored a run in the final game at Ebbets Field, scored the first Dodger run in both the Los Angeles Coliseum and Dodger Stadium, and blasted the first home run in Dodger Stadium. He was also a notable bridge between MLB and the Negro Leagues. Gilliam is the only player to hit a home run in both the Negro League East-West All-Star Game (1950) and the Major League All-Star Game (1959) and is one of the few players to win both a Negro League Championship and a World Series. Gilliam never commanded the spotlight yet was influential in the Dodgers reaching seven World Series, winning four during his career. He never had a permanent position and was frequently the subject of trade rumors. In the meticulously
