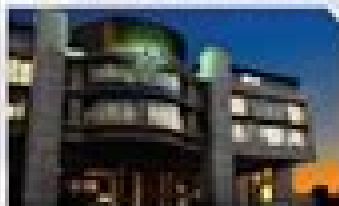
All students, including students whose fees are paid by sponsors or employers, have to pay the following minimum amounts prior to or on the date of academic registration:

Reflections on the 2019 South African General Elections Joleen Steyn Kotze,Narnia Bohler-Muller,2020-12-18

Reflections on the 2019 South African General Elections is a critical reflection on the key lessons of Elections 2019 in South Africa focusing on the future of the country's electoral democracy. The volume engages questions on land election campaigns, voter turnout, voter apathy, and how opposition parties will be forced to co-exist in the context of declining electoral dominance. The ANC, once comfortably held, is an important reflection on the lessons of the 2019 South African General Elections. The contributors ask: Quo Vadis South Africa? The 2019 General Elections marked a watershed in South Africa's political landscape. The ANC, under the banner of a narrative of regeneration and getting back on the moral path, dipped below the 60 % mark for the first time in South Africa's democratic history. This decline in electoral support for the party may be interpreted as a degeneration of the ANC through the loss of its moral stature, the erosion of its integrity, and disillusionment with its performance as a governing party. Opposition political parties could not capitalise on this seeming disillusionment with the ruling ANC. Caught in their own factional battles and in the midst of corruption scandals, opposition parties were unable to successfully increase their share of the vote and capture the undecided and disillusioned voter. Considering the future of South Africa's electoral democracy at 25 years of democracy, Reflections on the 2019 South African General Elections will be of great interest to scholars of African Studies, South Africa Governance and Elections. The chapters in this book were originally published as a special issue of *Politikon: South African Journal of Political Studies*. [Dominance and Decline](#) Susan Booyesen,2015-10-01 As Jacob Zuma moves into the twilight years of his presidency, of both the African National Congress (ANC) and of South Africa, this book takes stock of the Zuma-led administration and its impact on the ANC. [Dominance and Decline: The ANC in the Time of Zuma](#) combines hard-hitting arguments with astute analysis. Susan Booyesen shows how the ANC has become centred on the personage of Zuma and that its defence of his extremely flawed leadership undermines the party's capacity to govern competently and to protect its long-term future. Following on from her first book, *The African National Congress and the Regeneration of Power* (2011), Booyesen delves deeper into the four faces of power that characterise the ANC. Her principal argument is that the state is failing as the president's interests increasingly supersede those of party and state. Organisationally, the ANC has become a hegemon riven by factions as the internal blocs battle for core positions of power and control. Meanwhile, the Zuma-controlled ANC has witnessed the implosion of the tripartite alliance and decimation of its youth, women's and veterans' leagues. Electorally, the leading party has been ceding ground to increasingly assertive opposition parties. And on the policy front, it is faltering through poor implementation and a regurgitation of old ideas. As Zuma's replacements start competing and succession politics take shape, Booyesen considers whether the ANC will recover from the damage wrought under Zuma's reign and attain its former glory. Ultimately, she

believes that while the damage is irrevocable the electorate may still reward the ANC for transcending the Zuma years This is a must have reference book on the development of the modern ANC With rigour and incisiveness Booysen offers scholars and researchers a coherent framework for considering future patterns in the ANC and its hold on political power
