

Notes 2 Urban Geography

Settlement- an area where people live and interact; ranging from small villages to megacities. Urban geography- the study of cities (location, sizes, land use, and urban problems). City: an inhabited place of greater size, human population, and importance that is clustered together to serve as a center of politics, culture, and economics. Cities serve a variety of functions: providing jobs, providing basic social services; and being centers of trade, business, culture, and creativity. Over half of the world's people live in cities. *Factors influencing the growth of cities: location near key resources, transportation, and trade routes, ease to defend (near landforms like hills, mountains, islands, etc.) -Job opportunities in the cities motivate people to migrate from rural areas to cities. Workers provide cheap, plentiful labor for factories. In less developed countries, however, there are not enough jobs for the people looking for employment, creating a large surplus labor force. The influx keeps wages low, and leads to poverty in many urban areas. Foreign companies use these workers because they produce goods for far less cost. -The size of cities increases because people continue to move into them, this is called urbanization, as more people move to cities, each city develops into lands, and changes the environment. Cities all over the world face many of the same problems: poor housing, poverty, homelessness, pollution, crime, and violence. The rapid growth of cities strains their capacity to provide services such as energy, education, health care, transportation, sanitation, and physical security. -The unregulated spreading of urban areas onto undeveloped land is called urban sprawl, scattered development that increases traffic, saps local resources, and destroys open space. -Some cities are trying to be proactive and establish measures aimed at fighting urban sprawl by limiting construction and using innovative land-use planning techniques or community cooperation. -One new form of land use is called "smart growth" or "New Urbanism," in which cities plan the communities' growth in a strategic way for livable and walkable neighborhoods. -Edge Cities: modern cities with one or more major highways and along these roads are clusters of office buildings and big shopping centers. -"Boomers" are developed around a shopping mall or highway, a "greenfield" is a master-planned city built on undeveloped land, and "uptown" edge cities are historic activity centers built over an older city or town. -A world city is a huge urban area functioning as an important center of economic power and wealth, especially in the global economic systems. Global banks, government institutions, and businesses are located there; Tokyo, New York City, London. --World cities have international diverse cultures, an active influence on and interaction in world affairs, a large population, a major international airport, and an advanced transportation system.	Describe a world city. What is an example of a world city?
<u>The Structure of Cities.</u> -City models try to explain where different types of people and businesses tend to exist within the urban setting. Urban structure can also refer to the urban spatial structure, which concerns the arrangement of public and private space in cities and the degree of connectivity and accessibility. -The central place theory is a spatial theory in urban geography that attempts to explain the reasons behind the distribution patterns, size, and number of cities and towns around the world; it attempts to illustrate how settlements are located in relation to one another. Central business office district (CBD): city centers dominated by large stores, offices, and buildings; transportation hubs where roads, railroads, and buses come together. Outside CBDs are: <i>factories and warehouse</i> (need large amounts of land); further is <i>Housing</i> which takes up most of the land, at major road junctions are small shopping strips with convenience stores lining major streets; and even further is the <i>Suburbs</i> with the newest houses, once were small towns engulfed by a spreading city or areas once farmland. -The concentric zone model was the first to explain distribution of social groups within urban areas. Based on a single city, Chicago, it shows that a city grows outward from a central point in a series of rings. -The sector model proposed that a city develops in sectors instead of rings. Certain areas of a city are more attractive for various activities, whether by chance or geographic and environmental reasons. As the city grows and these activities flourish and expand outward, they do so in a wedge shape and become a sector of the city. The multiple nuclei model shows that a city contains more than one center around which activities revolve. Some activities are attracted to particular nodes while others try to avoid them.
