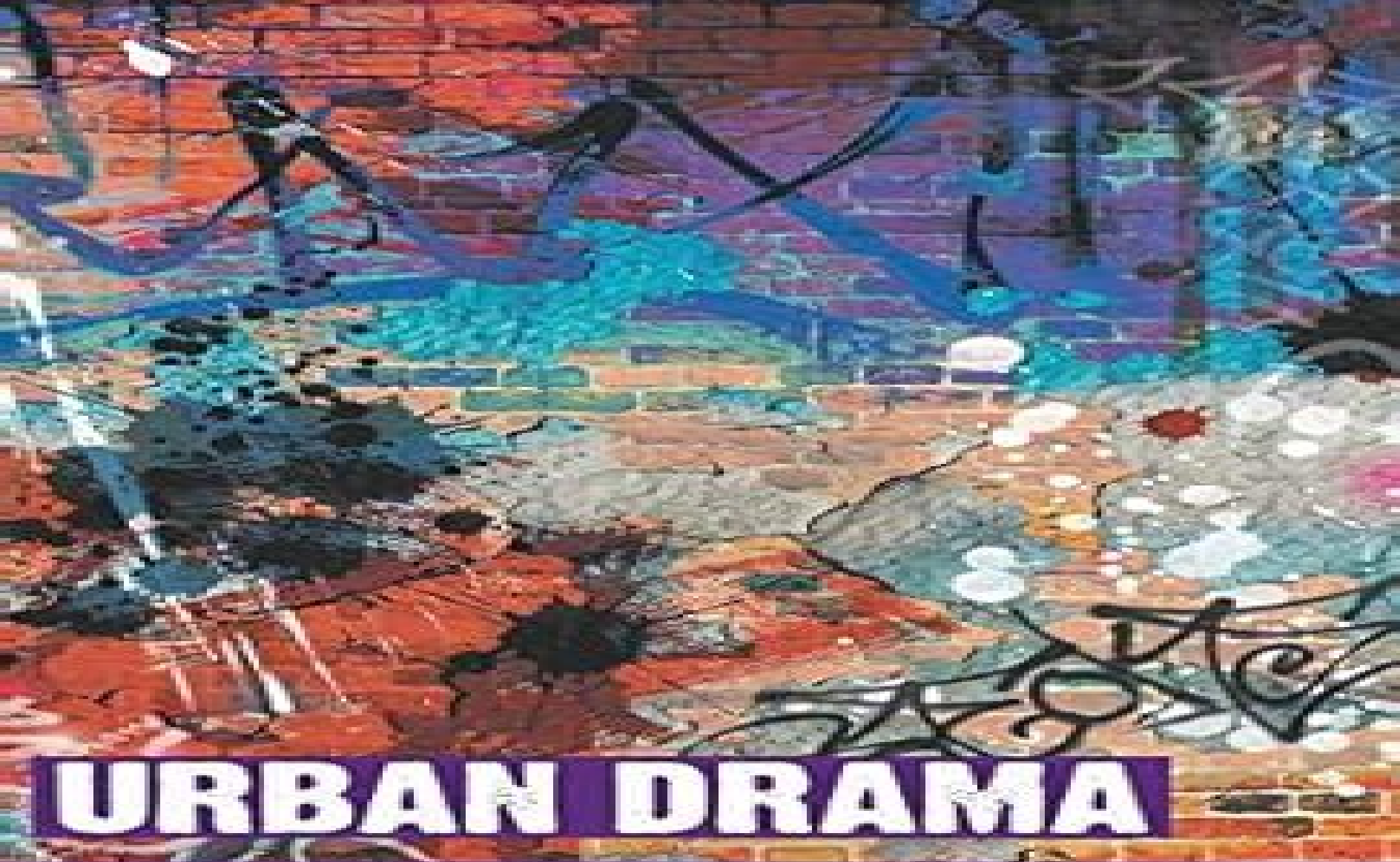

Re-Inventing the Postcolonial (in the) Metropolis Cecile Sandten, Annika Bauer, 2016-09-27 The notion of the postcolonial metropolis has gained prominence in the last two decades both within and beyond postcolonial studies Disciplines such as sociology and urban studies however have tended to focus on the economic inequalities class disparities and other structural and formative aspects of the postcolonial metropolises that are specific to Western conceptions of the city at large It is only recently that the depiction of postcolonial metropolises has been addressed in the writings of Suketu Mehta Chris Abani Amit Chaudhuri Salman Rushdie Aravind Adiga Helon Habila Sefi Atta and Zakes Mda among others Most of these works probe the urban specifics and physical and cultural topographies of postcolonial cities while highlighting their agential capacity to defy appropriate and abrogate the superimposition of theories of Western modernity and urbanism These ASNEL Papers are all concerned with the idea of the postcolonial in the metropolis from various disciplinary viewpoints as drawn from a great range of cityscapes spread out over five continents The essays explore on the one hand ideas of spatial subdivision and inequality political repression social discrimination economic exploitation and cultural alienation and on the other the possibility of transforming reinventing and reconfiguring the postcolonial condition in and through literary texts and visual narratives In this context the volume covers a broad spectrum of theoretical and thematic approaches to postcolonial and metropolitan topographies and their depictions in writings from Australia and New Zealand South Africa South Asia and greater Asia as well as the UK addressing issues such as modernity and market economies but also caste class and social and linguistic aspects At the same time they reflect on the postcolonial metropolis and postcolonialism in the metropolis by concentrating on an urban imaginary which turns on notions of spatial subdivision and inequality political repression social discrimination economic exploitation and cultural alienation as the continuing postcolonial condition

Brecht, Broadway and United States Theater J. Chris Westgate, 2009-05-05 Not long after the 2001 terrorist attacks in New York City Bertolt Brecht's name was on the lips of many writing about Broadway Invoked knowingly but not always knowledgeably Brecht became something between marketing strategy and erudite

justification for another season of Broadway musicals another ignominy endured by the German playwright whose epic theater has only seldom been understood in the United States To say that Brechtian and Broadway theatrical traditions represent divergence of philosophy method or ambition is to indulge with the whimsy of Mark Twain in understatement Nevertheless many references to Brecht since 2001 imply compatibility instead of contradiction a confusion or corruption that suggested the need of looking closely at what Brecht wrote and intended in his epic theater more than seventy years after his first and unfortunately typical experience with United States theater Beginning with the 1935 production of *The Mother* and moving through recent productions of political theater including *The Resistible Rise of Arturo Ui* *Urinetown* *The Musical* and *My Name is Rachel Corrie* this anthology considers the encounters of Brecht and Broadway in terms of dramaturgy performance and reception The essays in this anthology explore the political cultural and economic constraints shaping many of the encounters of Brecht and Broadway in U S theater history This means looking at how in many cases epic theater has been co opted and commodified by Broadway and what that commodification reveals about the culture of theater Simultaneously this means theorizing how epic theater finds or can find ways of providing a necessary bulwark against Broadway escapism and what this suggests for the future of political theater in the U S What results is a dialectical history tracing Brecht's encounters with Broadway a history that opens up and debates the complicated and often conflicted influence of Bertolt Brecht on United States theater Dr Westgate's book on Brecht and Broadway is an excellent study of the reception of Brecht's work in the American theater and academe Brecht along with Moliere Ibsen and Chekhov is one of the most frequently performed playwrights in translation in America A thorough investigation of the trajectory of Brecht stagings on Broadway has long been overdue I am very grateful that Dr Westgate has taken on the task and arrived at such a splendid result The book is a must reading for any serious Brecht scholar Carl Weber Stanford Drama Department Collaborator with Brecht at the Berliner Ensemble Director of many Brecht stagings in the U S This is a provocative collection of essays outlining the sometimes unexpected connections between Brecht and the Broadway theatre Like Brecht himself these essays are playful argumentative and productively dialectical in their contradictions The book is both entertaining and educational and bound to provoke healthy debate I recommend it as a demonstration of the ongoing relevance of Brechtian theories of theatre to the analysis of mainstream commercial theatre Sean Carney Associate Professor McGill University

Performance, Trauma and Puerto Rico in Musical Theatre Colleen Rua, 2023-08-11 This study positions four musicals and their associated artists as mobilizers of defiant joy in relation to trauma and healing in Puerto Rico This book argues that the historical trajectory of these musicals has formed a canon of works that have reiterated resisted or transformed experiences of trauma through linguistic ritual and geographic interventions These traumas may be disaster related migrant related colonial or patriarchal Bilingualism and translation ritual action and geographic space engage moments of trauma natural disaster incarceration death and healing community celebration grieving emancipation in these works The musicals

considered are West Side Story 1957 2009 2019 The Capeman 1998 In the Heights 2008 and Hamilton 2015 Central to this argument is that each of the musicals discussed is tied to Puerto Rico either through the representation of Puerto Rican characters and stories or through the Puerto Rican positionality of its creators The author moves beyond the musicals to consider Lin Manuel Miranda as an embodied site of healing that has been met with controversy as well as post Hurricane Maria relief efforts led by Miranda on the island and from a distance In each of the works discussed acts of belonging shape notions of survivorship and witness This book also opens a dialogue between these musicals and the work of island based artists Y no hab a luz that has served as sites of first response to disaster This book will be of interest to students and scholars in Latinx Theatre Musical Theatre and Translation studies *Literary Geography* Lynn M. in early modern England and many laborers even London citizens from more prosperous trades could expect to experience periods of impoverishment. This group of precarious laborers included actors and playwrights many of whom had direct connections to London's more established trades and occupations. Scholars have argued that dispossessed laborers turned to other forms of labor in lieu of their traditional livelihoods including brigandage piracy begging and cozening. To this list of alternative communities and applications of labor in the early modern period Matthew Kendrick's scholarship adds the London theaters. Each chapter is guided by the central premise that anxiety over the objectification and dispossession of labor in its various forms is enacted on stage and that drama helps to formulate by merit of the theater's socioeconomic identity an emerging laboring subjectivity engendered by the violent development of capitalism. As the nexus of a declining feudal social structure and an emerging capitalist regime of commodity production a location in which dispossessed labor intersected with traditions of skilled labor and the unwieldy consumerist energies of the marketplace the space of the theater was uniquely situated to channel and give dramatic form to the growing antagonisms and tensions that shaped labor. The stage offers a space in which to negotiate the value and meaning of labor in an increasingly exploitative society.

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
