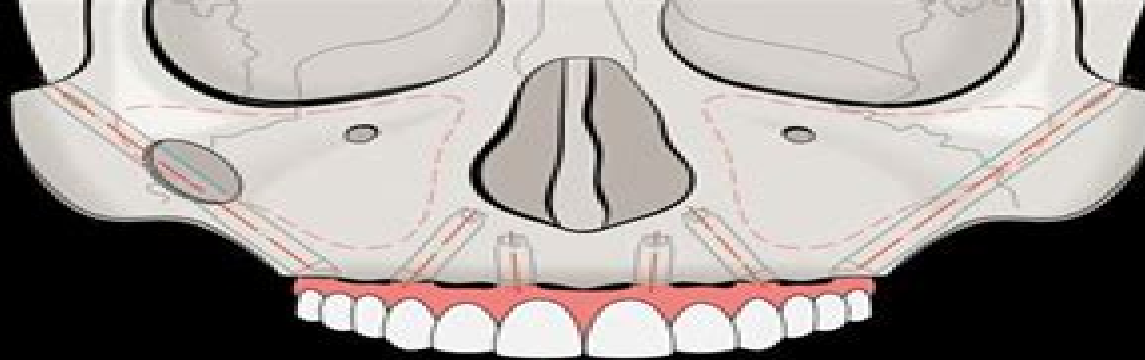
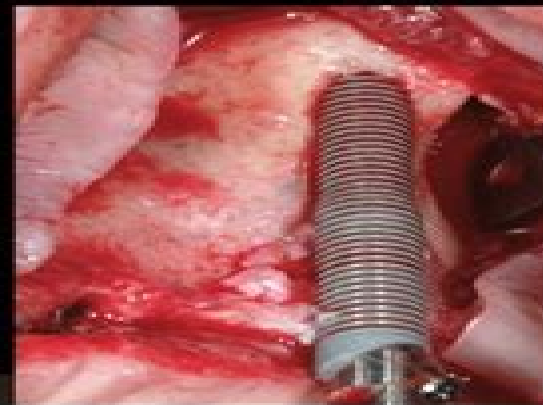

Thus, a technique of relative complexity becomes minimally invasive in its application.
