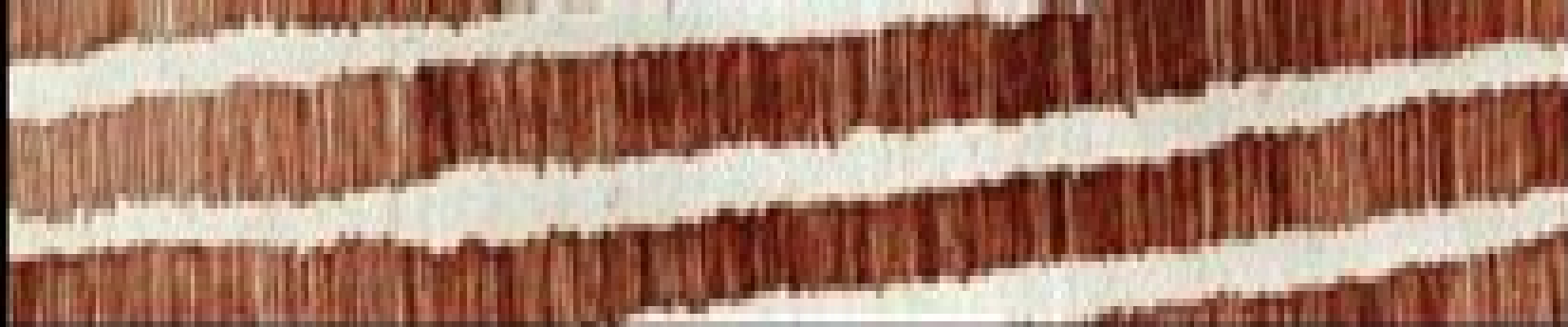
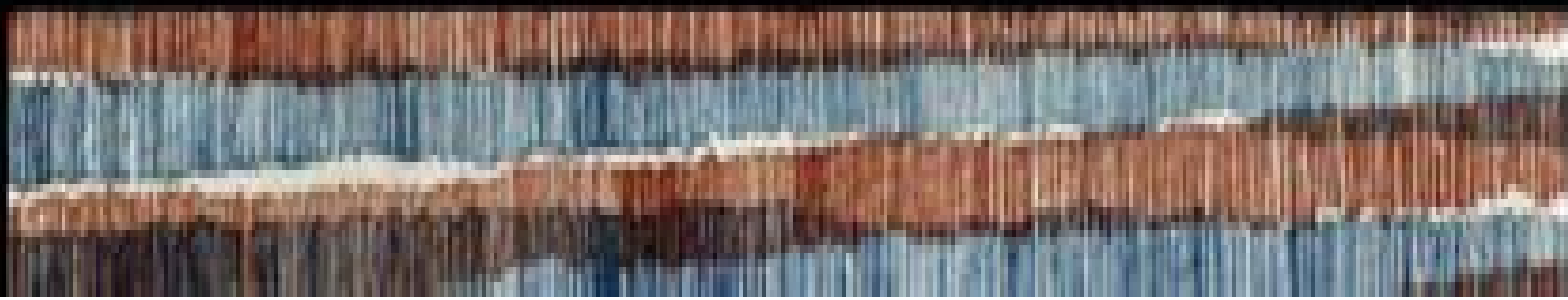

Writing Across Cultures Angel Rama, 2012-05-29 Angel Rama was one of twentieth century Latin America's most distinguished men of letters. Writing across Cultures is his comprehensive analysis of the varied sources of Latin American literature. Originally published in 1982, the book links Rama's work on Spanish American modernism with his arguments about the innovative nature of regionalist literature and it foregrounds his thinking about the close relationship between literary movements such as modernism or regionalism and global trends in social and economic development. In Writing across Cultures, Rama extends the Cuban anthropologist Fernando Ortiz's theory of transculturation far beyond Cuba, bringing it to bear on regional cultures across Latin America where new cultural arrangements have been forming among indigenous, African, and European societies for the better part of five centuries. Rama applies this concept to the work of the Peruvian novelist, poet, and anthropologist José María Arguedas, whose writing drew on both Spanish and Quechua, Peru's two major languages, and by extension, cultures. Rama considered Arguedas's novel *Los ríos profundos* (Deep Rivers) to be the most accomplished example of narrative transculturation in Latin America. Writing across Cultures is the second of Rama's books to be translated into English.

Franco, 2017 This book is in the Cambria Latin American Literatures and Cultures Series headed by Román de la Campa the Edwin B and Lenore R Williams Professor of Romance Languages at the University of Pennsylvania During the twentieth century the production of autobiographical writing in Latin American literature has intensified Since the beginning of the 1990s Latin American writings of the self autobiographies journals memoirs have emerged as a rich and varied corpus of Latin American literature both for the quantity of texts and for reasons of aesthetic relevance How can this development be explained What change if any has taken place that can explain this narrative inflection To what drives or cultural logics does it respond Responding to these questions can be difficult since the relations between society and artistic production are far from mechanical there are diverse cultural mediations at stake Even so in what follows I will attempt to set forth some considerations that might help to clarify the situation **Autobiographical Writing in Latin America** *Folds of the Self* is intended to fill a void With the exception of this book's antecedent *At Face Value* **Autobiographical Writing in Spanish America** 1991 by Sylvia Molloy there are no similar publications Molloy's foundational text studies a distinct period the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries as well as a different set of authors than the five analyzed in this book This study examines the diversity of narrative strategies utilized by these authors to design their written life not only with respect to the future that is to history but rather in terms of their own present deliberately inserting themselves into their societies In conclusion this book's novelty and innovation lies in its examination of a corpus that has never before been systematically studied This book proposes a reflection on contemporary Spanish American autobiographical discourse through four essays It examines the Spanish American autobiographical discourse in terms of the invalidation or problematization of the great metanarratives of progress and liberation the debilitation of the political the emergence of marginal and marginalized subjectivities an increased ecological consciousness the climax of a social trend towards the visual and the spatial as well as the vindication of intimism and the value of sensitivity and everyday socialities The primary audience for this book are academics specializing in the canonical authors studied Jos Agustín Reinaldo Arenas Jos Donoso Salvador Elizondo Gabriel García Márquez Carlos Monsivís Mario Vargas Llosa just to name the more famous ones Specialists in autobiographies and memoirs as well as historians sociologists and cultural critics studying Spanish

Mestizo Nations Juan E. De Castro, 2002-05 Nationality in Latin America has long been entwined with questions of racial identity Just as American born colonial elites grounded their struggle for independence from Spain and Portugal in the history of Amerindian resistance constructions of nationality were based on the notion of the fusion of populations heterogeneous in culture race and language But this rhetorical celebration of difference was framed by a real life pressure to assimilate into cultures always defined by Iberian American elites In *Mestizo Nations* Juan De Castro explores the construction of nationality in Latin American and Chicano literature and thought during the nineteenth and twentieth centuries Focusing on the discourse of mestizaje which proposes the creation of a homogenous culture out of American Indian black and Iberian elements he examines a selection of texts that represent the entire history and regional landscape of Latin American culture in its Western indigenous and neo African traditions from Independence to the present Through them he delineates some of the ambiguities and contradictions that have beset this discourse Among texts considered are the Indianist novel *Iracema* by the nineteenth century Brazilian author Jos de Alencar the *Tradiciones peruanas* Peruvian Ricardo Palma s fictionalizations of national difference and historical and sociological essays by the Peruvian Marxist Jos Carlos Mari tegui and the Brazilian intellectual Gilberto Freyre And because questions raised by this discourse are equally relevant to postmodern concerns with national and transnational heterogeneity De Castro also analyzes such recent examples as the Cuban dance band Los Van Van s use of Afrocentric lyrics Richard Rodriguez s interpretations of North American reality and points of contact and divergence between Jos Mar a Arguedas s novel *The Fox from Up Above* and the *Fox from Down Below* and writings of Gloria Anzald a and Julia Kristeva By updating the concept of mestizaje as a critical tool for analyzing literary text and cultural trends incorporating not only race culture and nationality but also gender language and politics De Castro shows the implications of this Latin American discursive tradition for current critical debates in cultural and area studies *Mestizo Nations* contains important insights for all Latin Americanists as a tool for understanding racial relations and cultural hybridization creating not only an important commentary on Latin America but also a critique of American life in the age of multiculturalism

Villoro who are currently reshaping media and audiences in Latin America In a world overwhelmed by data production and marked by violent acts against those considered others Liliana Ch vez D az argues that storytelling plays an essential role in communication among individuals classes and cultures

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
