Writing Without Words Elizabeth Hill Boone, Walter Mignolo, 1994 The history of writing or so the standard story goes is an ascending process evolving toward the alphabet and finally culminating in the full writing of recorded speech Writing without Words challenges this orthodoxy and with it widespread notions of literacy and dominant views of art and literature history and geography Asking how knowledge was encoded and preserved in Pre Columbian and early colonial Mesoamerican cultures the authors focus on systems of writing that did not strive to represent speech Their work reveals the complicity of ideology in the history of literacy and offers new insight into the history of writing The contributors who include art historians anthropologists and literary theorists examine the ways in which ancient Mesoamerican and Andean peoples conveyed meaning through hieroglyphic pictorial and coded systems systems inseparable from the ideologies they were developed to serve We see then how these systems changed with the European invasion and how uniquely colonial writing systems came to embody the post conquest American ideologies The authors also explore the role of these early systems in religious discourse and their relation to later colonial writing Bringing the insights from Mesoamerica and the Andes to bear on a fundamental exchange among art history literary theory semiotics and anthropology the volume reveals the power contained in the medium of writing Contributors Elizabeth Hill Boone Tom Cummins Stephen Houston Mark B King Dana Leibsohn Walter D Mignolo John Monaghan John M D Pohl Joanne Rappaport Peter van der Loo **Exploring and**

encuadernaciones previas permitiendo que conexiones antes aceptadas como la autoría de Francisco Gualpuyogualcal sean reexaminadas. Women such as Mary Rowlandson, Ann Eliza Bleecker, Lydia Maria Child, and the pseudonymous Unca Eliza Winkfield of *The Female American*, Rex argues co-opted and revised images of Indianness such as those found in the Massachusetts Bay Colony seal and the numerous variations of Pocahontas's image based on Simon Van de Passe's original 1616 engraving. Doing so allowed them to posit their own identities and presumed superiority as American women writers. Sometimes ugly, occasionally problematic, and often patently racist, the Indian

writings of these women nevertheless question the masculinist and Eurocentric discourses governing an American identity that has always had Indianness at its core Rather than treating early American images and icons as ancillary to literary works Rex places them in conversation with one another suggesting that these well known narratives and images are mutually constitutive The result is a new more textually inclusive perspective on the field of early American studies

Oral Discourse and Education Bronwyn Davies,P.
