conversation about how the feedback provided impacts the learning in the course SGID Conversation 2 Students Consultant Then there is a conversation between the consultant and the instructor where they discuss how the feedback provided by the students can best inform the pedagogical approaches and strategies used by the instructor SGID Conversation 3 Consultant Instructor Finally the instructor closes the feedback loop with a conversation with their students about what they learned and how best to move forward SGID Conversation 4 Instructor Students These conversations during the middle of the semester change the way students think about the teaching and learning endeavor the way instructors perceive the learning challenges of their courses and the quality of the institutional academic culture Most importantly the SGID equips the instructor with the knowledge to make midsemester course corrections that can profoundly impact the ways students navigate the course communicate with the instructor and realize the ways effective teaching can enhance learning
