This Way to the Revolution Erin Pizzey, 2011 By the early 1970s the women's movement was sweeping the Western world Erin Pizzey was one of millions hoping for change but found herself disagreeing with its more radical aims Committed to the idea of women offering mutual support she opened a community centre in a house in Chiswick London Soon the house filled up with battered women and children The offspring of violent parents herself she understood their plight Domestic abuse was regarded as something for families to settle behind closed doors and a woman who left a man was deemed to have made herself homeless with her children sent into care Erin established the first refuge in the world for battered women and children in 1971 She had a bitter fight on her hands not only with the women's movement outraged by her findings that women were as capable of violence as men but by priests who called her a marriage wrecker as well as councils social services and law courts which tried to get the overcrowded shelter closed down Before long though people began to realize the value of her work

The Memoirs of Toussaint and Isaac Louverture Arthur F. Saint-Aubin, 2015-07-15. This book examines the memoir of Toussaint Louverture, a former slave general in the French army and leader of the Haitian Revolution, and the memoir of his son Isaac. The Revolution and its leaders have been studied and written about extensively. Until recently, 2004, however, the memoir of Toussaint has received little attention and only as a historical document. This is the first study that explores the 1802 work foremost as a literary text, a creative production that deploys the techniques of fiction and drama to make truth claims about the past. Moreover, this is the first book-length study of Isaac Louverture's memoir. The two texts are read as examples of how black men thought of themselves as men, citizens, and therefore how they expressed their masculinity at that historical moment as experiences of mourning and loss. This study builds upon three areas of scholarship: the tradition of memoir writing, historicist readings of Toussaint's memoir, and descriptions and theories of men and masculinity within the black Atlantic. The study distinguishes itself in ways that will make it of interest to more than just historians. In addition to using the intersection of race and masculinity as an analytical tool, it speaks to the nature of literary creativity and it draws from studies examining the relationship between history, memory, and fiction. As a result, scholars and students in literary and cultural criticism, as well as those in gender and diasporic studies, will also find this study of interest and value.

Young, 2021-06-21 In 1884 the first of 68 prisoners convicted of terrorism and revolutionary activity were transferred to a new maximum security prison at Shlissel burg Fortress near St Petersburg The regime of indeterminate sentences in isolation caused severe mental and physical deterioration among the prisoners over half of whom died But the survivors fought back to reform the prison and improve the inmates living conditions The memoirs many survivors wrote enshrined their story in revolutionary mythology and acted as an indictment of the Tsarist autocracy s loss of moral authority Writing Resistance features three of these
