Allegiance to them has frequently impeded open minded investigation into how grapevines interact with the environment thus limiting innovation in winegrowing In *Terroir and Other Myths of Winegrowing* Mark A Matthews applies a scientist s skepticism and scrutiny to examine widely held beliefs about viticulture Is terroir primarily a marketing ploy that obscures understanding of which environments really produce the best wine Is reducing yield an imperative for high quality grapes and wine What does it mean to have vines that are balanced or grapes that are physiologically mature Matthews explores and dissects these and other questions to debunk the myths of winegrowing that may be holding us back from achieving a higher wine quality
