early decades of the twenty first century would be at best a sign of a severe lack of philosophical sensitivity On the other hand whether or not this shift has been towards greater importance and in respect to what is not only a legitimate but a necessary question to ask

The Speculative Turn Levi Bryant, Levi R. Bryant, Nick Srnicek, Graham Harman, 2011 Continental philosophy has entered a new period of ferment The long deconstructionist era was followed with a period dominated by Deleuze which has in turn evolved into a new situation still difficult to define However one common thread running through the new brand of continental positions is a renewed attention to materialist and realist options in philosophy Among the current giants of this generation this new focus takes numerous different and opposed forms It might be hard to find many shared positions in the writings of Badiou DeLanda Laruelle Latour Stengers and Zizek but what is missing from their positions is an obsession with the critique of written texts All of them elaborate a positive ontology despite the incompatibility of their results Meanwhile the new generation of continental thinkers is pushing these trends still further as seen in currents ranging from transcendental materialism to the London based speculative realism movement to new revivals of Derrida As indicated by the title The Speculative Turn the new currents of continental philosophy depart from the text centered hermeneutic models of the past and engage in daring speculations about the nature of reality itself This anthology assembles authors of several generations and numerous nationalities who will be at the center of debate in continental philosophy for decades to come
