Walden Henry David Thoreau,2004-08-11 Henry David Thoreau was just a few days short of his twenty eighth birthday when he built a cabin on the shore of Walden Pond and began one of the most famous experiments in living in American history Originally he was not apparently intending to write a book about his life at the pond but nine years later in August of 1854 Houghton Mifflin s predecessor Ticknor and Fields published Walden or a Life in the Woods At the time the book was largely ignored and it took five years to sell out the first printing of two thousand copies It was not until 1862 the year of Thoreau s death that the book was brought back into print Since then It has never been out of print Published in hundreds of editions and translated into virtually every modern
