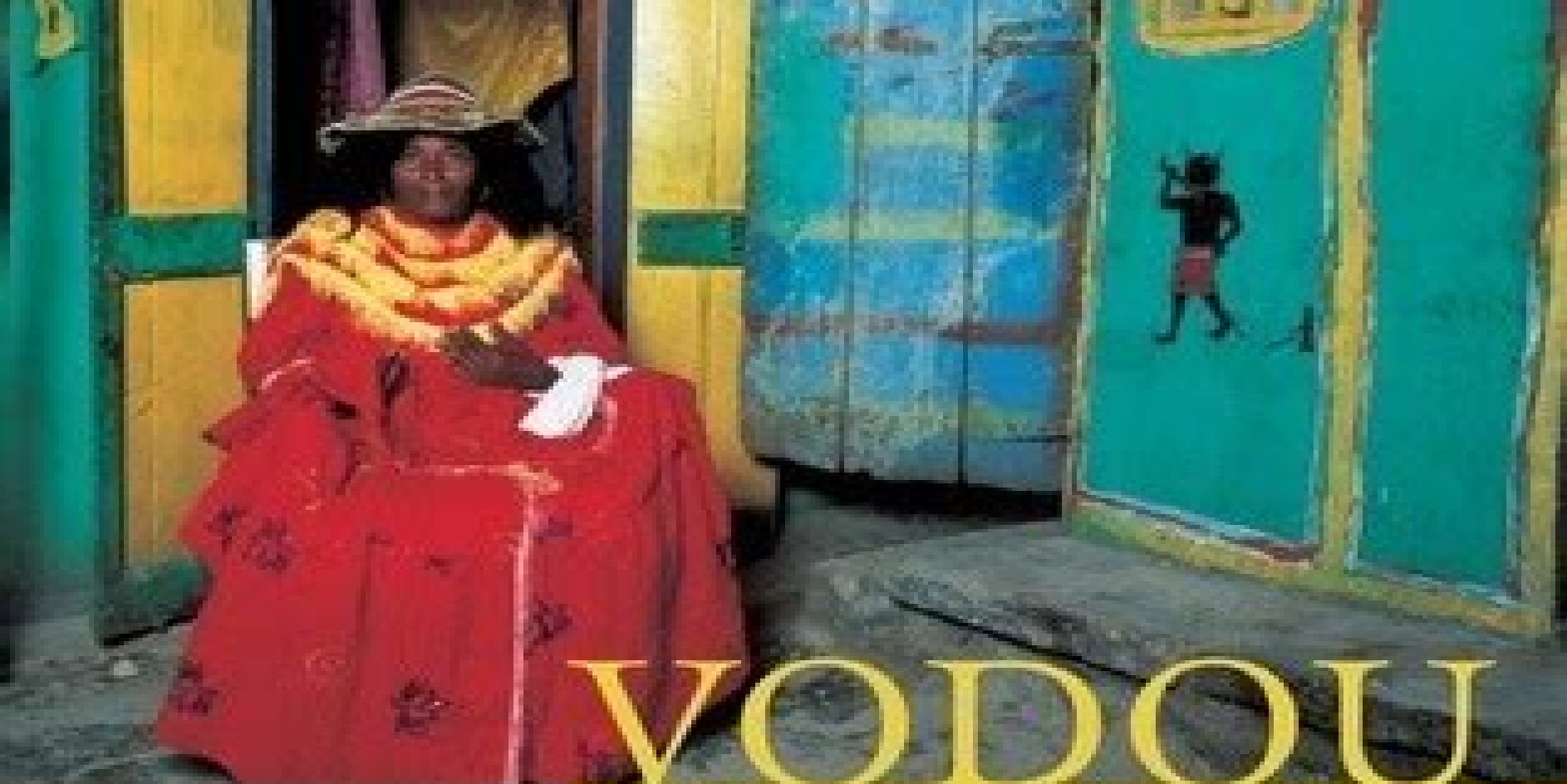

The Haitian Vodou Handbook Kenaz Filan, 2006-11-10 A working guide to the proper methods of interacting with the full Vodou pantheon Includes the myths cultural heritage and ancestral lineage of the lwa and how to honor and serve them Provides an introduction and guide that is especially useful for the solitary practitioner Discusses the relationship between Vodou Haitian culture and Catholicism In *The Haitian Vodou Handbook* Kenaz Filan an initiate of the Soci t la Belle Venus presents a working guide to the proper methods of interacting with the full Vodou pantheon explaining how to build respectful relationships with the lwa the spirits honored in Haitian Vodou and how to transform the fear that often surrounds the Vodou religion Until recently the Haitian practice of Vodou was often identified with devil worship dark curses and superstition Some saw the saint images and the Catholic influences and wrote Vodou off as a Christian aberration Others were appalled by the animal sacrifices and the fact that the Houngans and Mambos charge money for their services Those who sought Vodou because they believed it could harness evil forces were disappointed when their efforts to gain fame fortune or romance failed and so abandoned their voodoo fetishes Those who managed to get the attention of the lwa often received cosmic retaliation for treating the spirits as attack dogs or genies which only further cemented Vodou's stereotype as dangerous Filan offers extensive background information on the featured lwa including their mythology and ancestral lineage as well as specific instructions on how to honor and interact fruitfully with those that make themselves accessible This advice will be especially useful for the solitary practitioner who doesn't have the personal guidance of a soci t available Filan emphasizes the importance of having a quickened mind that can read the lwa's desires intuitively in order to avoid establishing dogma based relationships This working guide to successful interaction with the full Vodou pantheon also presents the role of Vodou in Haitian culture and explores the symbiotic relationship Vodou has maintained with Catholicism

Cleophas, 2016-05-05 One glaring lacuna in studies of Haitian Vodou is the scarcity of works exploring the connection between the religion and its main roots traditional Yoruba religion Discussions of Vodou very often seem to present the religion in vacuo as a sui generis phenomenon that arose in Saint Domingue and evolved in Haiti with no antecedents What is sorely needed then is more comparative studies of Haitian Vodou that would examine its connections to traditional Yoruba religion and thus illuminate certain aspects of its mythology

This tradition of scapegoating stretches back to the nation's founding and forms part of a contest over the legitimacy of the religion both beyond and within Haiti's borders. *The Spirits and the Law* examines that vexed history asking why from 1835 to 1987 Haiti banned many popular ritual practices. To find out, Kate Ramsey begins with the Haitian Revolution and its aftermath. Fearful of an independent black nation inspiring similar revolts, the United States, France, and the rest of Europe ostracized Haiti. Successive Haitian governments seeking to counter the image of Haiti as primitive as well as contain popular organization and leadership outlawed spells and later superstitious practices. While not often strictly enforced, these laws were at times the basis for attacks on Vodou by the Haitian state, the Catholic Church, and occupying U.S. forces. Beyond such offensives, Ramsey argues that in prohibiting practices considered essential for maintaining relations with the spirits, anti-Vodou laws reinforced the political marginalization, social stigmatization, and economic exploitation of the Haitian majority. At the same time, she examines the ways communities across Haiti evaded, subverted, redirected, and shaped enforcement of the laws. Analyzing the long genealogy of anti-Vodou rhetoric, Ramsey thoroughly dissects claims that the religion has impeded Haiti's development.
