

fixing and embedding specimens using a microtome	light or electrons travel through specimens to create images; very thin sections of specimens greatly improves resolution

X-ray microscope	allows investigation of living cells and penetration of specimens without need for preparation; between light and electron microscopes for magnification and resolution
scanning helium Ion microscope	recent technology which provides good magnification and depth of field without damage to the specimen; still in the early stages; expensive

- Cell functioning encompasses the roles of the various organelles that comprise cells. As well as microscopy, some technologies that have enhanced our understanding of cell and organelle functioning are listed below.
  - Centrifugation separates cell parts. Homogenisation and centrifugation techniques developed in the 1950s allowed photosynthesis to occur in chloroplasts that were removed from cells. This biochemical process could be studied free from interference from other reactions.
  - Chromatography was developed as a separation technique so particular substances, e.g. the chlorophyll pigments involved in photosynthesis, could be isolated. The wavelengths of light they absorbed could then be investigated.
  - Tissue culture: plant, animal and immature cells have been cultured to allow experiments that would not be possible on whole organisms and to understand the process of cell differentiation.
  - Technologies have been developed for tracing the location or movement of materials, such as the use of radioisotopes of carbon and oxygen. The incorporation of green fluorescent protein markers into cells is used in molecular biology to track cellular processes and movements.
  - Digital technologies, such as data loggers and probes, are used for the detection of substances such as oxygen.

centrifugation: the process of separating parts of a complex mixture based on the increased rate of settling of dense materials; the process uses the centrifugal forces that result from rapidly spinning the mixture tissue culture: the growth of cells or tissues in a sterilised broth or agar medium
