Text Structure	Description
Introduction	The first paragraph should clearly state the topic and the writer's position on the topic. It should also grab the reader's attention and provide some background information on the topic.
Body Paragraphs	The next two or three paragraphs should provide the main arguments that support the writer's position. Each argument should be supported with evidence, examples, and explanations.
Counterarguments	The next paragraph should acknowledge the opposing viewpoint and provide counterarguments that refute it. This shows the writer has considered both sides of the argument.
Conclusion	The final paragraph should summarize the main points made in the essay and restate the writer's position in a clear and concise way. It should also include a call to action or a final thought to leave a lasting impression on the reader.
