Women, Peace and Security Funmi Olonisakin, Karen Barnes, Eka Ikpe, 2010-11-01 This book provides a critical assessment of the impact of UN Resolution 1325 by examining the effect of peacebuilding missions on increasing gender equality within conflict affected countries UN Resolution 1325 was adopted in October 2000 and was the first time that the security concerns of women in situations of armed conflict and their role in peacebuilding was placed on the agenda of the UN Security Council It was an important step forward in terms of bringing women's rights and gender equality to bear in the UN's peace and security agenda More than a decade after the adoption of this Resolution its practical reality is yet to be substantially felt on the ground in the very societies and regions where women remain disproportionately affected by armed conflict and grossly under represented in peace processes This realization in part led to the adoption in 2008 and 2009 of three other Security Council Resolutions on sexual violence in conflict violence against women and for the development of indicators to measure progress in addressing women peace and security issues The book draws together the findings from eight countries and four regional contexts to provide guidance on how the impact of Resolution 1325 can be measured and how peacekeeping operations could improve their capacity to effectively engender security This book will be of much interest to students of peacebuilding gender studies the United Nations international security and IR in general *Women, Peace and Security*, 2015 Wars kill and destroy lives of women girls men and boys There are particular gendered dimensions to violence that have a disproportionate and different impact on women and men Gender based violence GBV 1 such as sexual violence and domestic violence tend to increase during and after war At the same time postconflict peace and state building can be an opportunity to change discriminatory gender roles and advance women's rights and gender equality This brief gives an overview of the women peace and security agenda how it is positioned within the Swedish development cooperation and where the entry points are for Sida

Evaluation of the project "Strengthening the role of women in peacebuilding through natural resources management at the community level in the rural areas of the governorates of Sana'a and Lahaj in Yemen" Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, 2021-06-04 Women have traditionally played a role in water conflict resolution in rural areas The most transformative change the project has achieved is the institutionalization of this role through the Water User Associations WUAs so that women gain further acceptance within their communities The evaluation found that FAO and IOM should further explore the catalytic effect of this project in sustaining local peace prospects particularly with an enhanced role for women in conflict resolution and should build a necessary link to the national peacebuilding efforts This could be done through a cascading programming i e two three PBF projects to be designed and implemented sequentially so they can have a better chance to contribute to higher order outcomes The successful resolution of water conflicts and the restoration of water infrastructure through the CfW component had a direct effect on increased crop production and income of farmers The measures in place to promote the sustainability of the project and the continuation of improved agriculture once the project has come to an end rely on the increased capacity of WUAs to use their conflict resolution skills maintain the sites and find further support Youth were not explicitly targeted in conflict resolution activities but they represented the majority of the beneficiaries of cash for work CfW activities FAO and IOM should have a targeted approach if they are to work on youth peace and security They should also do a thorough assessment of the socioeconomic impacts of CfW on the Yemen context before rolling about a programme wide CfW or cash transfer activities in Yemen

Gender Equality in UN Peacekeeping Sally Anne Corcoran, 2024-04-23 This book investigates to what extent UNSCR 1325 WPS agenda has functioned in practice to advance women's equality and empowerment in the peacekeeping context and beyond The book examines whether widespread implementation of UNSCR 1325 and the broader WPS agenda via gender mainstreaming in UN operations has translated into increased gender equality in peacekeeping operations the broader UN institutional context and by extension the host countries in which missions are situated via norm dissemination The book investigates this via a review of the implementation of UNSCR 1325 in the operations chosen as research sites over three snapshot years The book undertakes a comparative analysis that scrutinizes if how and under what conditions gender mainstreaming has succeeded as a strategy to advance gender equality by analyzing the factors conditions that have led to successful gender mainstreaming across the operational context and those that have impeded this outcome The book concludes that despite rhetorical commitments to women's equality in peacekeeping since the passage of UNSCR 1325

progress on the ground has remained minimal and that the operational environment continues to be discriminatory against women Both quantitatively and qualitatively women do not participate as equal partners in peacekeeping and continue to have less access to resources and decision making power overall The book interrogates that by exploring the spaces available within law policy and practice of the UN to pursue the human rights agenda of gender equality and considers whether UNSCR 1325 has enlarged those spaces It also points to the irony of internal UN structures failing to adequately adapt to their own gender mainstreaming mandates while those same structures have delivered some gender equality mandates successes externally at local levels This book will be of interest to students of peacekeeping gender studies and International Relations
