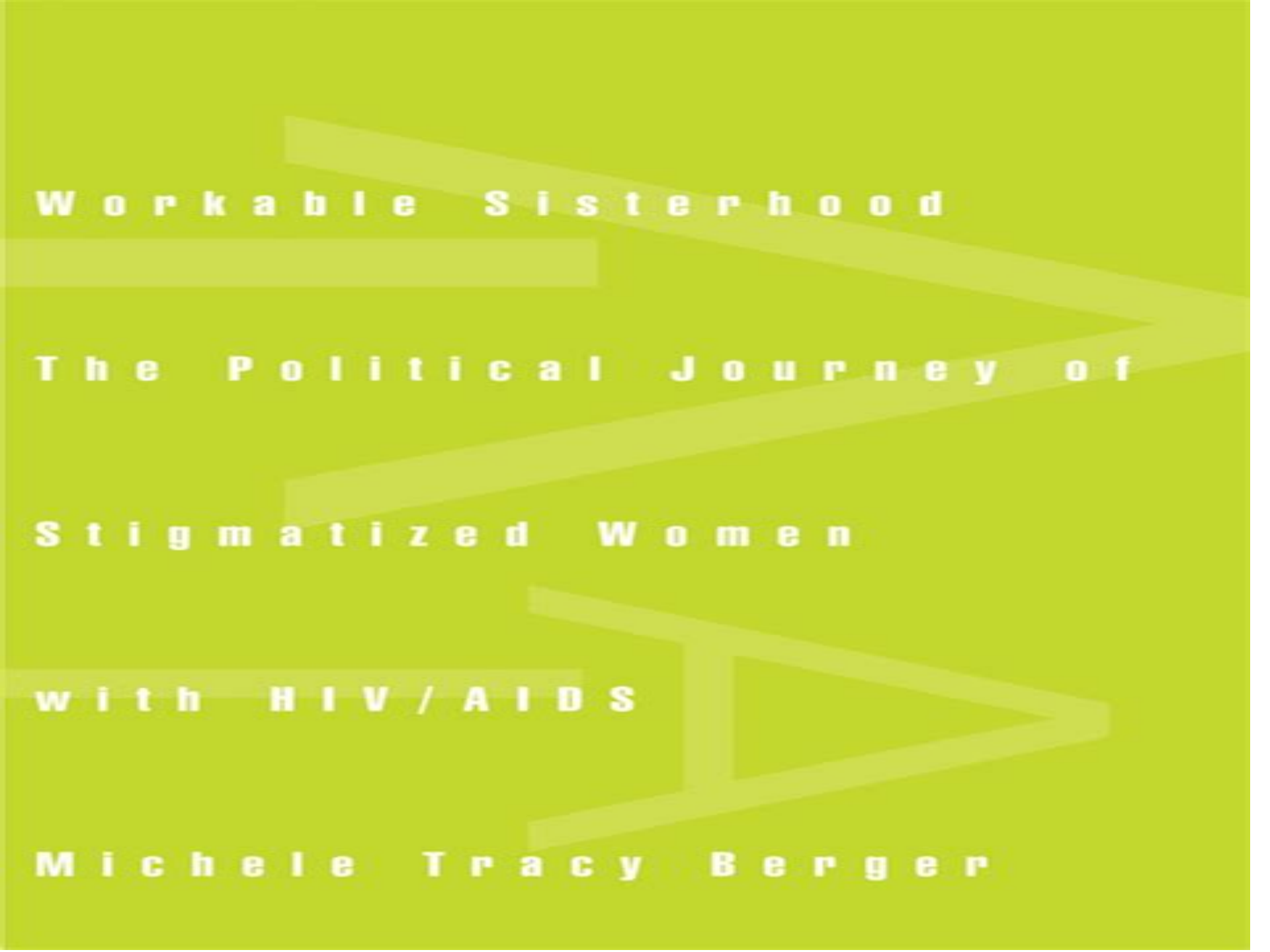

Workable Sisterhood Michele Tracy Berger, 2010-07-28 **Workable Sisterhood** is an empirical look at sixteen HIV positive women who have a history of drug use conflict with the law or a history of working in the sex trade What makes their experience with the HIV AIDS virus and their political participation different from their counterparts of people with HIV Michele Tracy Berger argues that it is the influence of a phenomenon she labels intersectional stigma a complex process by which women of color already experiencing race class and gender oppression are also labeled judged and given inferior treatment because of their status as drug users sex workers and HIV positive women The work explores the barriers of stigma in relation to political participation and demonstrates how stigma can be effectively challenged and redirected The majority of the women in Berger s book are women of color in particular African Americans and Latinas The study elaborates the process by which these women have become conscious of their social position as HIV positive and politically active as activists advocates or helpers She builds a picture of community based political participation that challenges popular medical and scholarly representations of crack addicted prostitutes and HIV positive women as social problems or victims rather than as agents of social change Berger argues that the women s development of a political identity is directly related to a process called life reconstruction This process includes substance abuse treatment the recognition of gender as a salient factor in their lives and the use of nontraditional political resources **Workable Sisterhood** , 2006 **Workable Sisterhood** ,

at the intersection of sociological and public health research Although the first AIDS cases were attributed to men having sex with men over 70% of HIV infections worldwide are now estimated to occur through sex between women and men In *Men at Risk* Shari L Dworkin argues that the centrality of heterosexual relationship dynamics to the transmission of HIV means that both women and men need to be taken into account in gender specific HIV AIDS prevention interventions She looks at the costs of masculinity that shape men s HIV risks such as their initiation of sex and their increased status from sex with multiple partners Engaging with the common paradigm in HIV research that portrays only women and not heterosexually active men as being vulnerable to HIV Dworkin examines the gaps in public health knowledge that result in substandard treatment for HIV transmission and infection among heterosexual men both domestically and globally She examines a vast array of structural factors that shape men s HIV transmission risks and also focuses on a relatively new category of global health programs with men known as gender transformative that seeks to move men in the direction of gender equality in the name of improved health Dworkin makes suggestions for the next generation of gender transformative health interventions by calling for masculinities based and structurally driven HIV prevention programming Thoroughly researched and theoretically grounded *Men at Risk* presents a unique approach to HIV prevention at the intersection of sociological and public health research

Lee, 2014-01-14 In *An Epidemic of Rumors* Jon D Lee examines the human response to epidemics through the lens of the 2003 SARS epidemic Societies usually respond to the eruption of disease by constructing stories jokes conspiracy theories legends and rumors but these narratives are often more damaging than the diseases they reference The information disseminated through them is often inaccurate incorporating xenophobic explanations of the disease s origins and questionable medical information about potential cures and treatment Folklore studies brings important and useful perspectives to understanding cultural responses to the outbreak of disease Through this etiological study Lee shows the similarities between the narratives of the SARS outbreak and the narratives of other contemporary disease outbreaks like AIDS and the H1N1 virus His analysis suggests that these disease narratives do not spring up with new outbreaks or diseases but are in continuous circulation and are recycled opportunistically Lee also explores whether this predictability of vernacular disease narratives presents the opportunity to create counter narratives released systematically from the government or medical science to stymie the negative effects of the fearful rumors that so often inflame humanity With potential for practical application to public health and health policy *An Epidemic of Rumors* will be of interest to students and scholars of health medicine and folklore

bedroom with several strangers Who are you and why would you choose to take part in this kind of study This book explores the hidden world of pharmaceutical testing on healthy volunteers Drawing on two years of fieldwork in clinics across the country and 268 interviews with participants and staff it illustrates how decisions to take part in such studies are often influenced by poverty and lack of employment opportunities It shows that healthy participants are typically recruited from African American and Latino communities and that they are often serial participants who obtain a significant portion of their income from these trials This book reveals not only how social inequality fundamentally shapes these drug trials but it also depicts the important validity concerns inherent in this mode of testing new pharmaceuticals These highly controlled studies bear little resemblance to real world conditions and everyone involved is incentivized to game the system ultimately making new drugs appear safer than they really are Adverse Events provides an unprecedented view of the intersection of racial inequalities with pharmaceutical testing signaling the dangers of this research enterprise to both social justice and public health
