Gorman,2011-12-01 Immortalized in the film *A League of Their Own* the All American Girls Professional Baseball League debuted in 1943 as a way to fill ballpark seats should Major League Baseball suspend operations during World War II Any fan expecting to see a watered down version of the game was in for quite a surprise The women on the field proved every bit as tough and competitive as their male counterparts running with abandon diving for catches and sliding fearlessly all while wearing uniforms with short skirts This work examines the history of the league as seen through the eyes of the players and management and the experiences of the South Bend Blue Sox one of only two teams to play in all 12 seasons of the league Although players never saw themselves as revolutionaries these daring heroines helped pave the way toward greater freedom of choice for the generations of women who followed **Baseball** Edward J. Williams,2020-05-01 Kat D Williams traces Isabel Lefty Alvarez s life from her childhood in Cuba where she played baseball with the boys on the streets of El Cerro to her reinvention as a professional baseball player and American citizen Isabel Lefty Alvarez gives the reader a look into Alvarez s young life in Cuba during the turbulent years leading up to Castro s revolution as political differences tore families apart Alvarez came to the United States at fifteen speaking no English and experienced the challenge of immigration as her mother pushed her to become a professional athlete in her newly adopted country Through all the changes and upheaval Alvarez found acceptance and success as a player in the All American Girls Professional Baseball League where she was called the Rascal of El Cerro After the league ended Alvarez struggled with an undiagnosed learning disability that limited her options She persevered and reinvented herself as a factory worker but later battled alcoholism and depression until baseball returned to her life and she was able to reconnect with her former teammates and become part of the active community of former players Alvarez s life story illustrates the struggle and strength of a young Latina immigrant and the importance of sport to her transition to her new country and her enduring identity
