



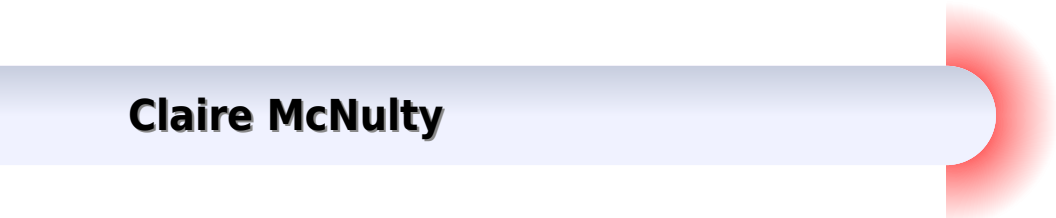

Meikle, 1999-11-16 This collection of essays addresses women in Scotland in the medieval and early modern period drawing on archival sources from Court of Session records to Middle Scots poetry The editors argue persuasively that it is important to know about Scotswomen from all social levels The book includes a time line and introductory bibliographical essay The twenty essays in the collection are arranged under the themes of religion literature legal history the economy politics and the family They demonstrate the connections between Scottish women's experience and those in England and the continent as well as highlighting what was unique for the history of Scottish women Through this comprehensive review of the feminine situation during more than six hundred years of Scottish history the reader will discover how women really lived and what they really thought whatever their place in society

The Punishment Monopoly Pem Davidson Buck, 2019-11-22 Examines the roots of white supremacy and mass incarceration from the vantage point of history Why asks Pem Davidson Buck is punishment so central to the functioning of the United States a country proclaiming liberty and justice for all The Punishment Monopoly challenges our everyday understanding of American history focusing on the constructions of race class and gender upon which the United States was built and which still support racial capitalism and the carceral state After all Buck writes a state to be a state has to punish bottom line that is what a state and the force it controls is for Using stories of her European ancestors who arrived in colonial Virginia in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries and following their descendants into the early nineteenth century Buck shows how struggles over the right to punish backed by the growing power of the state governed by a white elite made possible the dispossession of Africans Native Americans and poor whites Those struggles led to the creation of the low wage working classes that capitalism requires locked in by a metastasizing white supremacy that Buck's ancestors with many others defined as white helped establish and manipulate Examining those foundational struggles illuminates some of the most contentious issues of the twenty first century the exploitation and detention of immigrants mass incarceration as a central institution Islamophobia white privilege judicial and extra judicial killings of people of color and some poor whites The Punishment Monopoly makes it clear that none of these injustices was accidental or inevitable that shifting our state sanctioned understandings of history is a step toward liberating us from its control of the present

Female Agency in the Urban Economy Deborah Simonton, Anne Montenach, 2013-04-17 This innovative new book is overtly and explicitly about female agency in eighteenth century European towns However it positions female activity and decisions unequivocally in an urban world of institutions laws regulations customs and ideologies Gender politics complicated and shaped the day to day experiences of working women Town rules and customs as well as police and guilds regulations affected women s participation in the urban economy most of the time the formally recognized and legally accepted power of women which is an essential component of female agency was very limited Yet these chapters draw attention to how women navigated these gendered terrains As the book demonstrates exclusion is too strong a word for the realities and pragmatism of women s everyday lives Frequently guild and corporate regulations were more about situating women and regulating their activities rather than preventing them from operating in the urban economy Similarly corporate structures which were under stress

found flexible strategies to incorporate women who through their own initiative and activities put pressure on the systems Women could benefit from the contradictions between moral and social unwritten norms and economic regulations and could take advantage of the tolerance or complicity of urban authorities towards illicit practices Women with a grasp of their rights and privileges could defend themselves and exploit legal systems with its loopholes and contradictions to achieve economic independence and power

Women, Crime, and Forgiveness in Early Modern Portugal Darlene Abreu-Ferreira, 2016-03-09 Looking at the experiences of women in early modern Portugal in the context of crime and forgiveness this study demonstrates the extent to which judicial and quasi judicial records can be used to examine the implications of crime in women s lives whether as victims or culprits The foundational basis for this study is two sets of manuscript sources that highlight two distinct yet connected experiences of women as participants in the criminal process One consists of a collection of archival documents from the first half of the seventeenth century a corpus called querelas in which formal accusations of criminal acts were registered This is a rich source of information not only about the types of crimes reported but also the process that plaintiffs had to follow to deal with their cases The second primary source consists of a sampling of documents known as the perd o de parte The term refers to the victim s pardon unique to the Iberian

Peninsula which allowed individuals implicated in serious conflicts to have a voice in the judicial process By looking at a sample of these pardons found in notary collections from the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries Abreu Ferreira is able to show the extent to which women exercised their agency in a legal process that was otherwise male dominated
