Rockell, 2008 While the number of women in U S jails remains low in comparison with the number of men over the past 10 years their admission rate has soared and now surpasses the rate of increase for men While demographic information is available on these women it tells us little about who they are as people how they become repeat offenders or how they survive on the street The author sheds light on these issues in a study of female repeat offenders admitted to a New York state jail Despite the women s self defeating behaviors many of them reveal a surprising degree of initiative and self sufficiency This finding runs counter to previous research in which drug use and criminal activity by women have been viewed as reflecting the perpetrators victim status and lack of agency The author argues for seeing these behaviors in a broader social context and suggests avenues for future study as well as more humane and constructive intervention strategies

ethnographic research in Contra Costa County California CCC Pimping the Welfare System highlights a welfare program implemented after welfare reform that differed in significant ways from the predominant work first approach implemented by most welfare programs The book argues that by imparting dominant economic social and cultural capital CCC s welfare program empowered participants and improved their quality of life and life chances Successfully transmitting these types of capital however was dependent upon the discourses practices and pedagogy deployed by welfare workers as well as the policies practices and resources of the welfare program In particular CCC s welfare workers encouraged the acquisition and use of dominant capital that which is desired by the labor market by acknowledging and respecting the various types of capital welfare participants already had and by encouraging participants to make strategic choices about deploying different types of capital This book calls into question monolithic understandings of economic social and cultural capital and encourages a new conceptualization of capital that resists framing poor women as fundamentally lacking In addition it points to ways welfare administrators and welfare workers can develop more empowering programs even within the confines of federal state and local regulations

Street Woman Eleanor Miller, 1987-04 In this rich well written study Eleanor Miller analyzes the social organization of street hustling and the lives of the women involved in it Miller views hustling as illegal work prostitution fraud forgery embezzlement and larceny Using information garnered from life histories and interviews with 64 female street hustlers in Milwaukee she vividly describes a female underclass recruited to the world of the street for a substantial period of their lives *Street Woman* offers a challenging alternative to recent sociological studies that view the women s movement as directly linked to the increasing participation of women in property crime Miller shows that this increase in crime is a response to sustained poverty Thus many sociologists are out of touch with the typical female criminal in this country on both a demographic and personal level Typical female hustlers as their own words poignantly reveal are young poor minority women who have limited education and skills and who also have several children of their own They adopt characteristic interpersonal relationships and familial forms that insure their survival but which leave the youngsters at greater risk of being recruited to street life *Street Woman* is a work of great importance to sociologists and criminologists alike both in its ramifications for public policy and its explicit implications for further research Most important Miller s desire to render a more personal portrait to enable us to at least recognize the individual in the picture painted of the group leaves the reader with haunting portrayals of the women who struggle to survive in the violent desperate drug ridden world of the street Author note Eleanor M Miller is Assistant Professor of Sociology at the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee

struggle with gun violence and homicide The result has been the unnatural contortion of Black families and the inter generational perpetuation of social chaos and untimely death Young people are repeatedly ripped away from life by violence while many men are locked away in prisons In neighborhoods like those of Wilmington Delaware residents routinely face the pressures of violence death and incarceration Murder Town USA is thus a timely ethnography with an innovative structure the authors helped organize fifteen residents formerly involved with the streets and or the criminal justice system to document the relationship between structural opportunity and experiences with violence in Wilmington s Eastside and Southbridge neighborhoods Earlier scholars offered rich cultural analysis of violence in low income Black communities and yet this literature has mostly conceptualized violence through frameworks of personal responsibility or individual accountability And even if acknowledging the pressure of structural inequality most earlier researchers describe violence as the ultimate result of some moral failing a propensity for crime and the notion of helplessness Instead in Murder Town USA Payne Hitchens and Chamber along with their collaborative team of street ethnographers instead offer a radical re conceptualization of violence in low income Black communities by describing the penchant for violence and involvement in crime overall to be a logical resilient response to the perverse context of structural inequality
