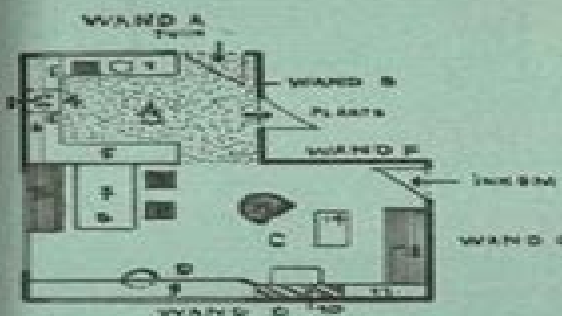

DE woonkamer bestaat uit een keukenhoek A, een eethoek B, een zithoek C, en een plaats waar de kinderen hun huiswerk kunnen maken D.

A. Keukenhoek.

In de wand A bevinden zich een deur en een groot raam, die uitkijken op de tuin. Onder het raam plaatsen we de spoeltafel (1) met kasten ernaast. Tegen de volle muur van de wand E zien we een lage kastkast (2), daarnaast het fornuis (4) en daarnaast doorlopende lage kasten (5). Boven deze lage kasten zien we hangkasten (6) en boven het fornuis een dampkap (3). Tussen de keukenhoek en eethoek lopen de lage kasten, waarvan zojuist sprake, verder door (5). Deze lage kasten vormen hier een verdeelmeubel waarop we alle eetgerief kunnen klaarzetten. Al deze lage kasten vanaf de spoeltafel tot de toegang van de keukenhoek naar de eethoek, vormen eenzelfde lijn van hoogte. In de wand B (volle muur) bevindt zich een deur die toegang verbergt tot een andere plaats van de woning. We voor-



lijding boven de spoeltafel en tegen de wand van de dampkap.

B. Eethoek.

Tegen het verdeelmeubel (5) aan, staat de tafel met een verlichtingsarm erboven. Tegen de wand E plaatsen we ernaast het raam een zitbank (16). Onder 8 verbergt twee
