sometimes referred to as The Wild is a lecture by Henry David Thoreau first delivered at the Concord Lyceum on April 23 1851 It was written between 1851 and 1860 but parts were extracted from his earlier journals Thoreau read the piece a total of ten times more than any other of his lectures Walking was first published as an essay in the Atlantic Monthly after his death in 1862 He considered it one of his seminal works so much so that he once wrote of the lecture I regard this as a sort

of introduction to all that I may write hereafter Walking is a Transcendental essay in which Thoreau talks about the importance of nature to mankind and how people cannot survive without nature physically mentally and spiritually yet we seem to be spending more and more time entrenched by society For Thoreau walking is a self reflective spiritual act that occurs only when you are away from society that allows you to learn about who you are and find other aspects of yourself that have been chipped away by society Walking is an important canon in the transcendental movement that would lay the foundation for his best known work Walden Along with Ralph Waldo Emerson s Nature and George Perkins Marsh s Man and Nature it has become one of the most important essays in the Transcendentalist movement Walking is a transcendental essay that analyzes the relationship between man and nature trying to find a balance between society and our raw animal nature I would not have every man nor every part of a man cultivated any more than I would have every acre of earth cultivated part will be tillage but the greater part will be meadow and forest While Thoreau does not want man to be fully socialized and lose his raw nature he does acknowledge that part of man will always be tillage farmers or people cultivating land people part of society Author Henry David Thoreau July 12 1817 May 6 1862 was an American essayist poet philosopher abolitionist naturalist tax resister development critic surveyor and historian A leading transcendentalist Thoreau is best known for his book Walden a reflection upon simple living in natural surroundings and his essay Civil Disobedience originally published as Resistance to Civil Government an argument for disobedience to an unjust state Thoreau s books articles essays journals and poetry amount to more than 20 volumes Among his lasting contributions are his writings on natural history and philosophy in which he anticipated the methods and findings of ecology and environmental history two sources of modern day environmentalism His literary style interweaves close observation of nature personal experience pointed rhetoric symbolic meanings and historical lore while displaying a poetic sensibility philosophical austerity and Yankee attention to practical detail He was also deeply interested in the idea of survival in the face of hostile elements historical change and natural decay at the same time he advocated abandoning waste and illusion in order to discover life s true essential needs He was a lifelong abolitionist delivering lectures that attacked the Fugitive Slave Law while praising the writings of Wendell Phillips and defending the abolitionist John Brown Thoreau s philosophy of civil disobedience later influenced the political thoughts and actions of such notable figures as Leo Tolstoy Mahatma Gandhi and Martin Luther King Jr Thoreau is sometimes referred to as an anarchist Though Civil Disobedience seems to call for improving rather than abolishing government I ask for not at once no government but at once a better government the direction of this improvement points toward anarchism That government is best which governs not at all and when men are prepared for it that will be the kind of government which they will have
