The Oxford Handbook of Modern and Contemporary American Poetry Cary Nelson, 2012-01-06 The Oxford Handbook of Modern and Contemporary American Poetry gives readers a cutting edge introduction to the kaleidoscopic world of American poetry over the last century Offering a comprehensive approach to the debates that have defined the study of American verse the twenty five original essays contained herein take up a wide array of topics the influence of jazz on the Beats and beyond European and surrealist influences on style poetics of the disenfranchised religion and the national epic antiwar and dissent poetry the AIDS epidemic digital innovations transnationalism hip hop and more Alongside these topics major interpretive perspectives such as Marxist psychoanalytic disability queer and ecocritical are incorporated Throughout the names that have shaped American poetry in the period Ezra Pound Wallace Stevens Marianne Moore Mina Loy Sterling Brown Hart Crane William Carlos Williams Posey Langston Hughes Allen Ginsberg John Ashbery Rae Armantrout Larry Eigner and others serve as touchstones along the tour of the poetic landscape John Ashbery and Anglo-American Exchange Oli Hazzard, 2018-06-07 In 1966 John Ashbery wrote The English language is constantly trying to stave off invasion by the American language it lives in a state of alert which is reflected to some degree in English poetry This book shows how the work of a major post war American poet has been centrally concerned with questions of national identity and intercultural poetic exchange by reading crucial episodes in Ashbery's oeuvre in the context of an other tradition of modern English poets he himself has defined This line runs from the editor of Ashbery's recent *Collected Poems* Mark Ford through Lee Harwood in the late 1960s F T Prince in the 1950s to chronologically the first and therefore most important influence on his own work W H Auden Through detailed close readings of the poetry of Ashbery and these English poets original interviews and extensive archival research a new account of Ashbery's aesthetic and a significant re mapping of post war English poetry is presented The biographical slant of the book is highly significant as it reads these writers poetry and correspondence together for the first time suggesting how major poetic innovations arose from specific social contexts from the particulars of relations between poets and also from a broader climate of Anglo American exchange as registered by each poet The book's presentation of the process of poetic influence is attentive to actual exchanges between contemporaries as evidenced in correspondence as opposed to speculative relationships with dominant figures and as such represents a departure from many other studies of Ashbery's work Key themes include Englishness as a national imaginary the concept of the minor reciprocal

Warhol's Working Class Anthony E. Grudin,2017-10-20 This book explores Andy Warhol s creative engagement with social class During the 1960s as neoliberalism perpetuated the idea that fixed classes were a mirage and status an individual achievement Warhol s work appropriated images techniques and technologies that have long been described as generically American or middle class Drawing on archival and theoretical research into Warhol s contemporary cultural milieu Grudin demonstrates that these features of Warhol s work were in fact closely associated with the American working class The emergent technologies Warhol conspicuously employed to make his work home projectors tape recorders film and still cameras were advertised directly to the working class as new opportunities for cultural participation What s more some of Warhol s most iconic subjects Campbell s soup Brillo pads Coca Cola were similarly targeted since working class Americans under threat from a variety of directions were thought to desire the security and confidence offered by national brands Having propelled himself from an impoverished childhood in Pittsburgh to the heights of Madison Avenue Warhol knew both sides of this equation the intense appeal that popular culture held for working class audiences and the ways in which the advertising industry hoped to harness this appeal in the face of growing middle class skepticism regarding manipulative marketing Warhol was fascinated by these promises of egalitarian individualism and mobility which could be profound and deceptive generative and paralyzing charged with strange forms of desire By tracing its intersections with various forms of popular culture including film music and television Grudin shows us how Warhol s work disseminated these promises while also providing a record of their intricate tensions and transformations **The Beauty of a Social Problem** Walter Benn Michaels,2015-07-13 Bertolt Brecht once worried that our sympathy for the victims of a social problem can make the problem s beauty and attraction invisible In *The Beauty of a Social Problem* Walter Benn Michaels explores the effort to overcome this difficulty through a study of several contemporary artist photographers whose work speaks to questions of political economy Although he discusses well known figures like Walker Evans and Jeff Wall Michaels s focus is on a group of younger artists including Viktoria Binshtok Phil Chang Liz Deschenes and Arthur Ou All born after 1965 they have always lived in a world where on the one hand artistic ambition has been synonymous with the critique of autonomous form and intentional meaning while on the other the struggle between capital and labor has essentially been won by capital Contending that the aesthetic

and political conditions are connected Michaels argues that these artists new commitment to form and meaning is a way for them to depict the conditions that have taken US economic inequality from its lowest level in 1968 to its highest level today As Michaels demonstrates these works of art unimaginable without the postmodern critique of autonomy and intentionality end up departing and dissenting from that critique in continually interesting and innovative ways

American Literature in Transition, 1950-1960 Steven Belletto, 2017-12-28 American Literature in Transition 1950 1960 explores the under recognized complexity and variety of 1950s American literature by focalizing discussions through a series of keywords and formats that encourage readers to draw fresh connections among literary form and concepts institutions cultures and social phenomena important to the decade The first section draws attention to the relationship between literature and cultural phenomena that were new to the 1950s The second section demonstrates the range of subject positions important in the 1950s but still not visible in many accounts of the era The third section explores key literary schools or movements associated with the decade and explains how and why they developed at this particular cultural moment The final section focuses on specific forms or genres that grew to special prominence during the 1950s Taken together the chapters in the four sections not only encourage us to rethink familiar texts and figures in new lights but they also propose new archives for future study of the decade

Poetry in General Keegan Cook Finberg, 2025-11-04 In the second half of the twentieth century poetry leapt out of books and became an interdisciplinary public form Poetry entered bureaucratic systems of organization like index card catalogues it pushed the boundaries of privately owned public parks Keegan Cook Finberg argues that poetry became an increasingly capacious force during this period because it could speak directly to the degradation of the social democratic notion of the public Poetry in General explores how poets expanded their practice into the realms of politics work and everyday life from 1960 to the present from the apex of the welfare state to an era of privatization and austerity It considers a compelling array of figures including Yoko Ono George Brecht Frank O Hara Amiri Baraka Bernadette Mayer Eleanor Antin Adrian Piper and M NourbeSe Philip whose works draw on conceptual techniques to transform official documents and spaces Finberg shows how these public texts expose the mechanisms of the neoliberal consensus about work and leisure the state s facilitation of capitalism and enduring racial and gender inequities She also provides politically charged ways to interpret and critique racial capitalism antiabortion legislation and mass debt A new literary and institutional history of postwar poetics this book shows how poetic experiments address the privatization of collective life and rethink the category of the public

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
