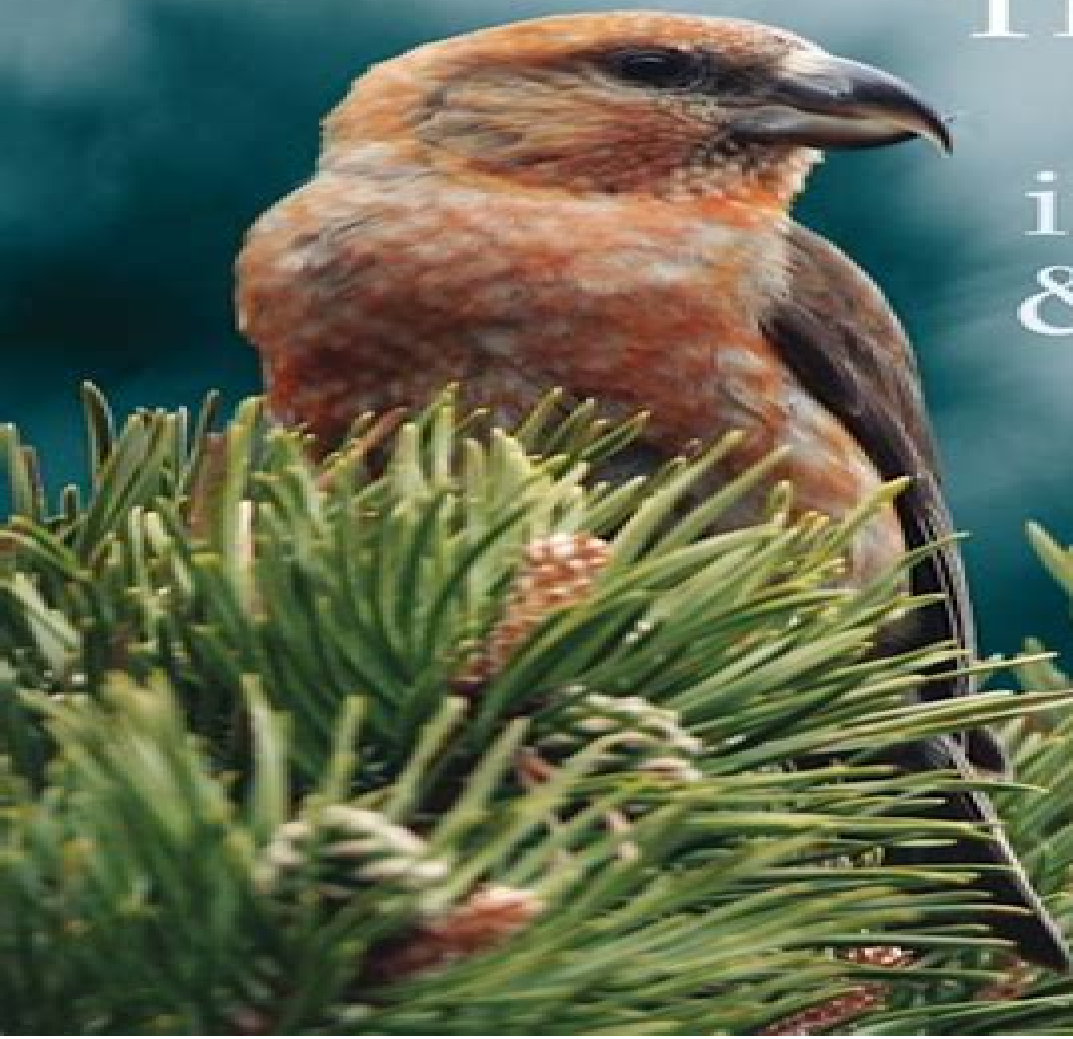

Tasker, Ken Partridge, 2010-10-30 The Status of Seabirds in Britain and Ireland book presents the most up to date information available on these seabird populations their numbers and distribution and their changing fortunes in recent years The oceanographic and coastal features of the British Isles provide a wealth of ideal habitats for breeding seabirds and it is no surprise that the British and Irish seabird populations are of international importance both in sheer numbers and in species diversity Indeed for some species British waters are host to the greater part of the world's population The Operation Seafarer survey carried out in 1969-70 provided a baseline for future work that led to the establishment of the Seabird Colony Register by the Seabird Group and the Nature Conservancy Council The results and analysis of their counts during 1985-87 form the basis for this book Improved census methodology and a new computerised database has set the standards for seabird monitoring in future decades In Part 1 the general biology and population trends of British seabirds are described to set the scene for Part 2 in which the results and analysis for each of the 24 breeding species are given in detail Full descriptions of the counting methods and the estimating factors used provide guidelines for future surveys not only in Britain but wherever seabirds are of interest and importance No one with an interest in seabirds or conservation can afford to be without this authoritative book nor but be grateful to the small army of professionals and amateurs who have so ably explored our coastal habitats Illustrated by Keith Brockie *The Status of Birds in Britain and Ireland* David Parkin, 2018-10 The Status of Birds in Britain and Ireland was written to update the British Ornithologists Union's last full Checklist published under the same title as far back as 1971 Since then there have been remarkable changes in both distribution and abundance of the region's birds Some species have become extinct as breeding birds whereas others have colonised and even become quite common many of our most familiar birds have suffered critical declines with changes in land use and climate Dozens of new species have occurred as vagrants and many previous vagrants now occur much more frequently Furthermore there has been a major revolution in bird taxonomy The book summarises all these changes and gives an up to date account of the status of the birds in Britain Ireland and the Isle of Man The book has been written by two former Chairmen of the British Ornithologists Union Records Committee and long serving members of the BOU Taxonomic Sub Committee It was compiled with the close cooperation of former colleagues in the BOU Records Committee and TSC as well as key figures in the Republic of Ireland Northern Ireland and the Isle of Man to ensure it reflects the official position in all the countries covered The Status only includes records accepted by the committees responsible for each of the countries follows the new taxonomy of the BOU and uses English names approved by the

International Ornithological Congress's working group on English names as also adopted by the BOU. As such the book is the only key text reflecting the official status of birds throughout Britain and Ireland as followed by bodies such as the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, the British Trust for Ornithology, the Joint Nature Conservation Council, BirdWatch Ireland, the BOU itself and many others. This companion volume to The Atlas of Breeding Birds of Britain and Ireland is derived from surveys of birds present in Britain and Ireland during the three winters 1981/82, 1982/83 and 1983/84. The surveys were organised by the British Trust for Ornithology and the Irish Wildbird Conservancy as were the earlier breeding birds surveys. The Winter Atlas maps 200 species, 192 of which have full page two colour maps faced by a page of text. The texts written by over 100 specialists comment on the survey results, the species generally and the distribution and abundance as mapped. In addition there are introductory chapters on the maps, the weather in the three winters, bird patterns and movements and appendices describing the planning, organisation, field methods and processing of the survey data from record cards to computer output and maps. A team of 23 artists led by Robert Gillmor has provided the line drawings which head the species accounts. **Checklist of Birds of Britain and Ireland** Alan G. Knox, 1992. Little Egret and Yellow legged Gull are two recent arrivals and it is also of international importance for wintering and passage populations of various species which breed in the far north of the Palearctic. A diverse and fascinating avifauna is augmented by visits from an impressive range of rarities from as far afield as Siberia and Canada. Nearctic vagrants in particular are well represented on the English list. This important new avifauna looks in detail at England and its birds, analysing present and historical data to present a complete picture of the status, range and abundance of every bird on the English list. *The Birds of Nottinghamshire* Nick Crouch, Jason Reece, Bernie Ellis, Chris du Feu, David Parkin, 2019-11-29. The last comprehensive review of Nottinghamshire's birds was produced more than four decades ago. Much has changed since then and a new avifauna is long overdue. This book draws together historic reports from the nineteenth century records from the files of the county bird club, Nottinghamshire Birdwatchers and data from national and regional surveys and monitoring programmes. The resulting account presents an overview of the present state of the county's birdlife set against a context of environmental and climatic change. The gravel pits in the Trent and Idle Valleys form major corridors for birds moving across Britain and Nottinghamshire has attracted more than its share of national rarities. These include Britain's first Egyptian Nightjar and

Lesser Yellowlegs in the nineteenth century Bufflehead Redhead Cedar Waxwing and breeding Black winged Stilts in the twentieth century and a memorable nesting attempt by European Bee eaters in 2017 The woods and heaths of Sherwood lying in the middle of the county also provide a haven for an array of iconic species including European Nightjar Eurasian Woodcock Honeybuzzard and Hawfinch This book describes the past and present status of the 334 species that have been recorded in Nottinghamshire up to 2018 Lavishly illustrated with photographs taken within the county and sketches from the internationally recognised artist Michael Warren it is intended to be an authoritative reference to the birds of Nottinghamshire
