Three Plays in a Greek Motif George W. Harper, 2014-08-17 More than 2 500 years ago the Athenians perfected the art of drama The fact it was strictly al fresco was a handicap but these ancient Greeks possessed imagination a commodity which is sadly lacking in our modern world Where everything has to be spelled out in graphic detail and nothing is left to the imagination Among the results of this dramatic presentation were such plays as Oedipus Rex and The Birds Which between them exemplify the tragic and comedic extremes of ancient Greek drama The great Athenian classical performances of the plays were invariably staged as triplets consisting of two tragedies and one comedy to relieve the tension They might extend over several days and involve rival authors who vied for the laurel wreath which betokened victory Here is a recreation of the Greek motif But it has been updated to conform to modern moods and situations The results may astonish by their differences from the ancient mode but they are consonant with both the ancient and modern worlds and may even acquire a few laurels in addition to many sneers

The Embassy, the Ambush, and the Ogre Roberto Morales-Harley, 2024-08-29 This volume presents a sophisticated and intricate examination of the parallels between Sanskrit and Greco Roman literature By means of a philological and literary analysis Morales Harley hypothesizes that Greco Roman literature was known understood and recreated in India Moreover it is argued that the techniques for adapting epic into theater could have been Greco Roman influences in India and that some of the elements adapted within the literary motifs specifically the motifs of the embassy the ambush and the ogre could have been Greco Roman borrowings by Sanskrit authors This book draws on a wide variety of sources including Iliad Phoenix Rhesus and Cyclops Greco Roman as well as Mah bh rata The Embassy The Five Nights and The Middle One Sanskrit The result is a well supported argument which presents us with the possibility of cultural exchange between the Greco Roman world and India a possibility which though hypothetical is worth acknowledging Due to its comparative nature this volume will appeal to both Indologists and Classicists including Mah bh rata scholars Sanskrit theater scholars and those interested in comparative work with Sanskrit literature It brings an original perspective to the field and provides inspiration for new lines of research

Acts of Compassion in Greek Tragic Drama James Franklin Johnson, 2016-10-27 The ability of human beings to feel compassion or empathy for one another and express that emotion by offering comfort or assistance is an important antidote to violence and aggression In ancient Greece the epics of Homer and the tragic dramas performed each spring in the Theater of Dionysus offered citizens valuable lessons concerning the necessity and proper application of compassionate action This book is the first full length examination of compassion *eleos* or *oiktos* in Greek as a dramatic theme in ancient Greek literature Through careful textual analysis James F Johnson surveys the treatment of compassion in the epics of Homer especially the Iliad and in the works of the three great Athenian tragedians Aeschylus Euripides and Sophocles He emphasizes reciprocity reverence and retribution as defining features of Greek compassion during the Homeric and Archaic periods In framing his analysis Johnson distinguishes compassion from pity Whereas in English the word pity suggests an attitude of superiority toward the sufferer the word compassion has a more positive connotation and implies equality in status between subject and object Although scholars have conventionally translated *eleos* and *oiktos* as pity Johnson argues that our modern day notion of compassion comes closest to encompassing the meaning of those two Greek words Beginning with Homer *eleos* normally denotes an emotion that entails action of some sort whereas *oiktos* usually refers to the emotion itself Johnson also draws associations between compassion and the concepts of fear and pity which Aristotle famously attributed to tragedy Because the Athenian plays are tragedies they mainly show the disastrous consequences of a world where compassion falls short At the same time they offer glimpses into a world where compassion can generate a more beneficial and therefore more hopeful outcome Their message resonates with today's readers as much as it did for fifth century Athenians

Maxwell Anderson and the Classical Tradition Robert J. Rabel, 2025-04-15 This book sheds new light on the dramatic works of the American playwright poet and lyricist Maxwell Anderson assessing the pervasive influence of Greek and Roman antiquity on his plays that dominated Broadway in the first half of the twentieth century Anderson is an important though often forgotten figure in the history of American drama and the Classical Tradition The book highlights Anderson's remarkably creative use of classical antiquity while also illustrating how he served as a first hand witness and reactor to some of the main social and political events of his time It explores Anderson's major theatrical works and adaptations of ancient Greek drama and poetry including *Winterset* *The Winged Victory* the never published *Ulysses Africanus* and *Bad Seed* as well as his later minor works Anderson found in tragedians such as Aeschylus Sophocles and Euripides ideal models for the dramatic portrayal of human emotion amidst the social and political backdrop of the

United States from the interwar period to the nuclear age which this book seeks to explore at length for the first time This volume is of interest to students and scholars of Classical Reception and the Classical Tradition as well as those working on twentieth century American literature drama history and politics

Gender and the City in Euripides' Political Plays Daniel Adam Mendelsohn, 2005 Daniel Mendelsohn makes use of insights into classical Greek conceptions of gender and Athenian notions of civic identity to demonstrate that the plays *Children of Herakles* and *Suppliant Women* by Euripides are subtle and coherent exercises in political theorizing
