Dean Acheson and the Obligations of Power Michael F. Hopkins, 2017-03-17 Dean Acheson was the most influential American diplomat of the twentieth century He shaped the pivotal shift in American foreign policy from isolation to engagement in global affairs This critical re evaluation of Acheson's public career analyzes his advocacy of intervention against Germany and Japan in 1939 1941 work on sanctions against Japan in 1941 contribution to the creation of new international institutions and campaigns to secure the support of Congress and the American public It scrutinizes his crucial role in the Truman Doctrine the Marshall Plan NATO the formation of democratic governments in Germany and Japan and involvement in the Korean War It examines his advice on Europe and Vietnam to presidents Kennedy Johnson and Nixon Acheson was the architect of the policy of containing the Soviet Union that endured to the end of the Cold War The book argues that Acheson was slower to abandon the prospect of understandings with the Soviets and the communists in China than his memoirs claim his focus on the North Atlantic did not exclude his deep concern for Asian and the policy of containment was part of his wider belief that American power brought the obligation to promote a stable international order

Harry Hopkins Christopher D. O'Sullivan, 2014-10-30 One of the most controversial figures of the New Deal Era Harry Hopkins elicited few neutral responses from his contemporaries Millions admired him and believed the New Deal agencies he headed had rescued them from despair but many of President Roosevelt's enemies passionately hated him and derisively called him the world's greatest spender or FDR's left wing Rasputin Hopkins was a paradoxical man a trained social worker who enjoyed the company of the swells attending cocktail parties and gambling at the track Once the quintessential New Dealer during World War II he single mindedly devoted himself to aiding the allies downplaying his previous commitment to social reform and rupturing his friendship with Eleanor Roosevelt among others He was sickly and underweight yet a profane and blunt spoken man lacking in any outward affectations of charisma Still FDR curiously saw Hopkins who moved into the White House on the very day that Germany invaded France in May 1940 as his most suitable successor the New Deal's legatee a possible Democratic nominee for president Much of what FDR accomplished would never have been possible without Hopkins whom the press described as not only FDR's most trusted official but also his most intimate personal friend Analyzing Hopkins role in wartime diplomacy and his personal relationships with the twentieth century's most indispensable leaders historian Christopher O Sullivan offers enormous insight into the most controversial aspects of FDR's foreign policy the New Deal Era and the beginning of modern American history

Daniel Webster Donald A. Rakestraw, 2021-09-09 Few names in American history are more recognizable than that of Daniel Webster No one would deny that Webster's substantive domestic achievements assured his prominent

place in American history and that his virtual embodiment of nation and union guaranteed his rank among the most significant personalities of the Jacksonian era. It can however be argued that his domestic resumé that garnered him the title Defender of the Constitution is rivaled by an impressive international one that yielded far reaching results for a nation still struggling to find a respectable position among the Atlantic powers. In fact his adroit handling of his signature accomplishment with Lord Ashburton earned him the additional title of Defender of Peace. Webster's foreign policy achievements are too often given short shrift falling victim to the textbook author's inclination to hold Webster to the dominant domestic narrative that would ultimately see the nation fractured. Donald A. Rakestraw focuses on Webster's critical diplomatic efforts that produced a legacy that ranges from the delineation of America's northeastern boundary with Canada to the prevention of a serious rupture with Britain from the advancement of national commercial expansion in the Pacific and East Asia to the establishment of a long lived model for U.S. extradition policy from his successful intervention on behalf of the so called Santa Fe prisoners in Mexico to his role in promoting a crucial Anglo American rapprochement.

Douglas MacArthur Russell D. Buhite, 2008-04-18 Buhite offers a trenchant evaluation of Douglas MacArthur's career in East Asia and his role in some of the most important military and diplomatic issues of the twentieth century. Concise and highly readable this biography considers diplomatic fact in light of psychological insight and asks us to look anew at both MacArthur and American involvement in the region. From Manila to Washington with Tokyo and Seoul in between readers follow the course of American foreign diplomacy in East Asia via MacArthur's own career. This fascinating intersection of personality and policy would make for newsreel footage and newspaper headlines such as when he waded ashore Luzon Island in the Philippines and sent Washington provocative communiqués about the People's Republic of China. Yet as Buhite shows grand gestures are not the substance of great foreign policy and MacArthur's reputation merits critical reassessment. That political philosophy fundamentally progressive and people first was driven by a vision of an empire of liberty a global confederation of republican nations in moral and political partnership and peaceful coexistence and was to take root in North America. Jefferson's vision influenced his domestic and foreign policies as president and the numerous letters he wrote after his presidency but never took root there or anywhere. Was that due to a defect of vision a view of human capacities and goodness at odds with reality or were historical forces at play which were antagonistic to the rooting and suckering of Jeffersonian republicanism. *Brent Scowcroft* David F. Schmitz, 2011-03-16 As National Security Advisor to President Gerald Ford advisor to President Ronald Reagan and as National Security Advisor to

President George H W Bush Brent Scowcroft was at the center of the ongoing debate over how to shape American foreign policy in the post war world As David F Schmitz makes clear in his new biography Scowcroft was a realist in his outlook on American foreign policy and an heir to the Cold War internationalism that had shaped that policy since 1945 During his most important service as George H W Bush s national security advisor Scowcroft sought to work with like minded Republicans and Democrats to construct a post Cold War foreign policy that would provide consistency and stability to American policymaking in a rapidly changing international environment defend the internationalist position from challenges and criticisms and buffer the conduct of diplomacy from the turbulence of domestic politics The type of bi partisan cooperation and internationalism that marked the pre Vietnam War years served as Scowcroft s guide to how to defend American interests and promote U S values and institutions globally While not always successful Scowcroft provided a consistent internationalist voice in the midst of change *Colin Powell* Christopher D.
