Innovation, Regional Integration, and Development in Africa Samuel Ojo Oloruntoba, Mammo Muchie, 2018-07-26 This edited volume discusses the role of innovation and regional integration in economic development in Africa. Over the past five decades post colonial African countries have struggled to break loose from the trap of poverty and underdevelopment through the adoption of various development strategies at regional national and continental levels. However the results of both national and regional efforts at advancing development on the continent have been mixed. Although the importance of agglomeration and fusion of institutions have long been recognized as possible path to achieving economic development in Africa the approach to regionalism has been unduly focused on market integration while neglecting other dimensions such as social policy mobility of labor educational policy biotechnology regional legislation manufacturing innovation and science and technology. This volume investigates the link between innovation regional integration and development in Africa arguing that the immediate and long term development of Africa lies not just in the structural transformation of its economies but in the advancement of scientific and innovation capacities. The book is divided into four parts. Part I addresses the theoretical and conceptual underpinnings of innovation and regional integration in Africa. Part II presents case studies which examine how regional economic institutions are fostering innovation in Africa. Part III of the book deals with sectoral issues on innovation and integrated development in Africa. Part IV sets the future research on innovation regional integration and development in Africa. Combining theoretical analysis and a comparative interdisciplinary approach this volume is appropriate for researchers and students interested in economic development political economy African studies international relations agricultural science and geography as well as policymakers in regional economic communities and the African Union.

From Antagonism to Re-engagement Kamidza, Richard, 2017-07-19 The book interrogates the European Union EU Zimbabwe Economic Partnership Agreement EPA negotiations covering trade in goods trade related rules and development cooperation. The negotiations coincided with EU's motives as the dominant development partner and Zimbabwe's state stakeholder fault lines creating dilemmas in the pursuit of a fair EPA outcome. As a result the economically weak Zimbabwe signed and ratified an asymmetrical interim EPA iEPA with an economically powerful EU in 2009 and 2012 respectively. Meanwhile direct bilateral re engagement which eluded the Government of National Unity GNU became real following ZANU PF landslide victory on 31 July 2013 that sufficiently altered the power balance to trigger the process between the former nemesis in support of iEPA domestication and social and economic development. ZANU PF government stopped blaming the EU and other western nations for the country's continued economic under performance signaling a softening approach on its part. Similarly the EU and its member states softened its perception on ZANU PF leadership leading to resumption and intensification of re engagement despite failure to implement the Global Political Agreement related constitutional and democratic reforms agreed by GNU. This re engagement was firmly endorsed when the EU and Zimbabwe signed an

agreement in July 2015 to normalise bilateral relations and start cooperation

Grid-locked African Economic Sovereignty Warikandwa, Tapiwa Victor, Nhemachena, Artwell, 2019-02-06 The emergent so called Fourth Industrial Revolution is regarded by some as a panacea for bringing about development to Africans This book dismisses this flawed reasoning Surfacing how investors are actually looting and plundering Africa how the industrial internet of things the gig economies digital economies and cryptocurrencies breach African political and economic sovereignty the book pioneers what can be called anticipatory economics which anticipate the future of economies It is argued that the future of Africans does not necessarily require degrowth postgrowth postdevelopment postcapitalism or sharing solidarity economies it requires attention to age old questions about African ownership and control of their resources Investors have to invest in ensuring that Africans own and control their resources Further it is pointed out that the historical imperial structural creation of forced labour is increasingly morphing into what we call the structural creation of forced leisure which is no less lethal for Africans Because both the structural creation of forced labour and the structural creation of forced leisure are undergirded by transnational neo imperial plunder theft robbery looting and dispossession of Africans this book goes beyond the simplistic arguments that Euro America developed due to the industrial revolutions
