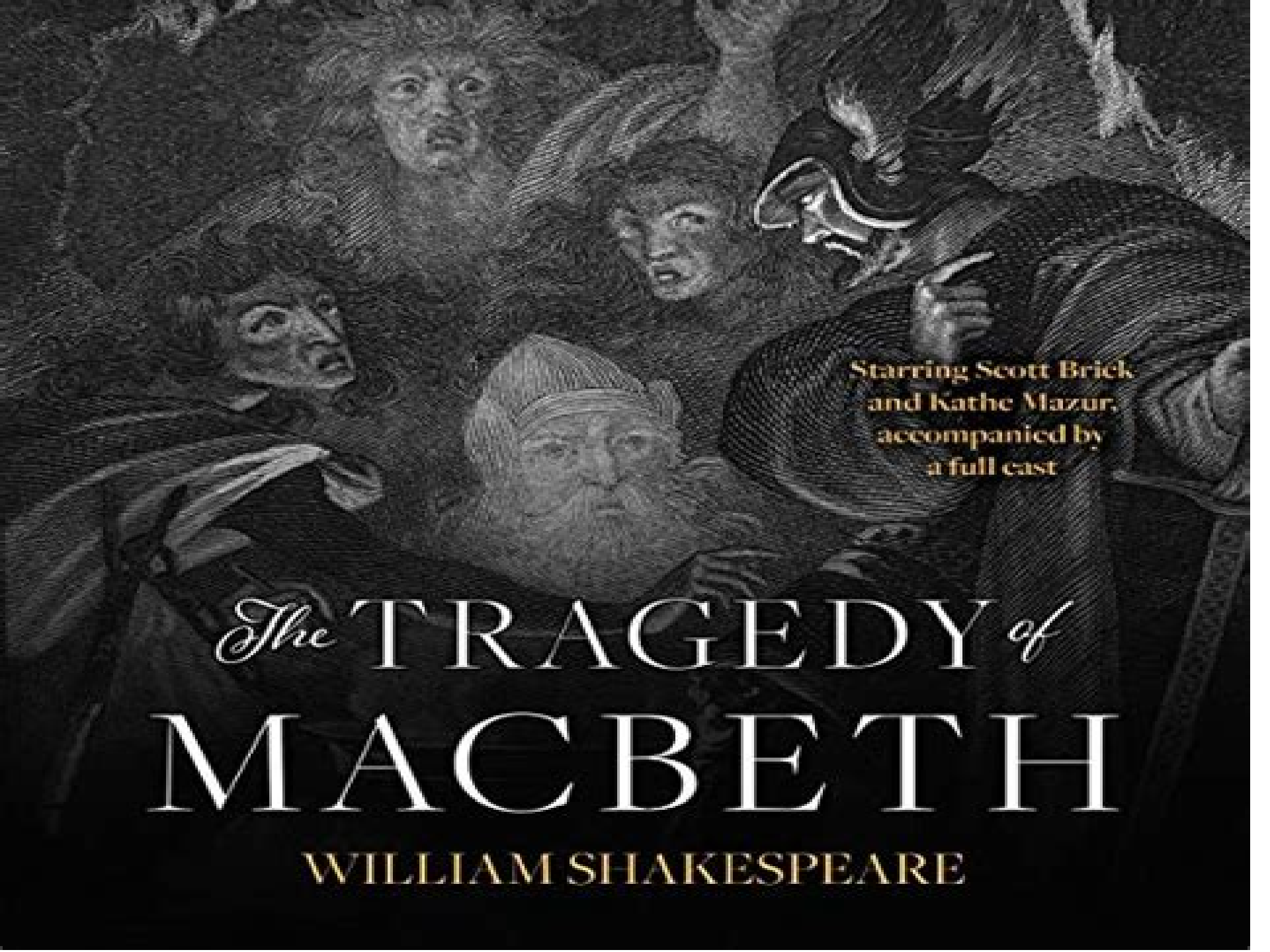

father a line of kings though he himself will not be one While the two men wonder at these pronouncements the witches vanish and another thane Ross arrives and informs Macbeth of his newly bestowed title Thane of Cawdor The first prophecy is thus fulfilled and Macbeth previously sceptical immediately begins to harbour ambitions of becoming king

The Tragedy of Macbeth, William Shakespeare William Shakespeare,2018-08-14 William Shakespeare 26 April 1564 baptised 23 April 1616 was an English poet playwright and actor widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world's pre eminent dramatist He is often called England's national poet and the Bard of Avon His extant works including collaborations consist of approximately 38 plays 154 sonnets two long narrative poems and a few other verses some of uncertain authorship His plays have been translated into every major living language and are performed more often than those of any other playwright Shakespeare was born and brought up in Stratford upon Avon Warwickshire At the age of 18 he married Anne Hathaway with whom he had three children Susanna and twins Hamnet and Judith Sometime between 1585 and 1592 he began a successful career in London as an actor writer and part owner of a playing company called the Lord Chamberlain's Men later known as the King's Men He appears to have retired to Stratford around 1613 at age 49 where he died three years later Few records of Shakespeare's private life survive which has stimulated considerable speculation about such matters as his physical appearance sexuality and religious beliefs and whether the works attributed to him were written by others
