Topographies of Japanese Modernism Seiji M. Lippit, 2002 What happens when a critique of modernity a revolt against the traditions of the Western world is situated within a non European context where the concept of the modern has been inevitably tied to the image of the West Seiji M Lippit offers the first comprehensive study in English of Japanese modernist fiction of the 1920s and 1930s Through close readings of four leading figures of this movement Akutagawa Yokomitsu Kawabata and Hayashi Lippit aims to establish a theoretical and historical framework for the analysis of Japanese modernism The 1920s and 1930s witnessed a general sense of crisis surrounding the institution of literature marked by both the radical politicization of literary practice and the explosion of new forms of cultural production represented by mass culture Against this backdrop this study traces the heterogeneous literary topographies of modernist writings Through an engagement with questions of representation subjectivity and ideology it situates the disintegration of literary form in these texts within the writers exploration of the fluid borderlines of Japanese modernity Rethinking Japanese Modernism Roy Starrs, 2011-10-14 Edited by Roy Starrs this collection of essays by an international group of leading Japan scholars presents new research and thinking on Japanese modernism a topic that has been increasingly recognized in recent years to be key to an understanding of contemporary Japanese culture and society By adopting an open multidisciplinary and transnational approach to this multifaceted topic the book sheds new light both on the specific achievements and on the often unexpected interrelationships of the writers artists and thinkers who helped to define the Japanese version of modernism and modernity Specific topics addressed include the literary modernism of major writers such as Akutagawa Kawabata Kajii Miyazawa and Murakami avant garde modernism in painting music theatre and in the performance art of Yoko Ono and the everyday modernism of popular culture and of new urban activities such as shopping and sports **Shirakaba and Japanese Modernism** Erin Schoneveld, 2019-01-04 *Shirakaba and Japanese Modernism* examines the most significant Japanese art and literary magazine of the early twentieth century *Shirakaba* White Birch 1910 1923 In this volume Erin Schoneveld explores the fluid relationship that existed between different types of modern visual media exhibition formats and artistic practices embraced by the *Shirakaba* ha White Birch Society Schoneveld provides a new comparative framework for understanding how the avant garde pursuit of individuality during Japan's Taisho period stood in opposition to state sponsored modernism and how this played out in the emerging media of art magazines This book analyzes key moments in modern Japanese art and intellectual history by focusing on the artists most closely affiliated with *Shirakaba* including Takamura Kitaro Umehara Ryuzaburō and Kishida Ryōsei who selectively engaged with and transformed modernist idioms of individualism and self expression to create a new artistic style that gave visual form to their own subjective reality Drawing upon archival research that includes numerous articles images and exhibitions reviews from *Shirakaba* as well as a complete translation of Yanagi Sōetsu's seminal essay *The Revolutionary Artist* Kakumei no gaka Schoneveld demonstrates that contrary to the received

narrative that posits Japanese modernism as merely derivative the debate around modernism among Japan's early avant garde was lively contested and self reflexive *The British Stake In Japanese Modernity* Michael Gardiner, 2019-09-30 This book describes firstly a Japanese modernity which is readable not only as a modernising but also as a Britishing and secondly modernist attempts to overhaul this British universalism in some well known and some less known Japanese texts From the mid nineteenth century and particularly as hastened by the spectre of China in the First Opium War Japan's modernity was bound up with a convergence with British Newtonian cosmology something underscored by the British presence in Meiji Japan and the British education of key Meiji state makers Moreover the thinking behind Britain's own unification in the long eighteenth century particularly the Scottish Enlightenment is echoed strikingly faithfully in the 1860s 70s work of Fukuzawa Yukichi Nakamura Masanao and other writers in the Japanese Enlightenment However from around the end of the Meiji era we can see a concerted and pointed response to this British universalism its historiography its basis in the sovereign individual subject and its spatial mapping of the world Elements of this response can be read in texts including Natsume S seki's *Kokoro* Watsuji Tetsu's *F do Climate and Culture* Tanizaki Jun ichir's *In ei Raisan* In Praise of Shadows Kawabata Yasunari's *Yukiguni* Snow Country and various work of the mid period Kyoto School Rarely understood in terms of its British specificity this response should have something to say to modernist studies more generally since it aimed at a pluralism and de universalisation that was difficult for mainstream British modernism itself Indeed the strength of this de universalisation may be precisely why these native Japanese modernist tendencies have not much been accepted as modernism within the Anglophone academy despite this field's apparent widening of its ground in the twenty first century *Satō Haruo and Modern Japanese Literature* Charles Exley, 2016-01-19 In *Sat Haruo and Modern Japanese Literature* Charles Exley offers the first comprehensive examination of Sat's literary oeuvre from the 1910s through the 1930s The study examines the ways in which selected novels and short stories interact with cultural discourses of the time including the fantastic the discourse on melancholy and mental illness detective fiction and early film colonial encounter and critique of civilization and hysteria and psychoanalysis Exley's alignment of Sat's fictional work with its cultural and historical context illustrates the complex ways in which Sat's aesthetic projections derived from and comment on Japan's experience with modernization during the twentieth century *Dandyism and Transcultural Modernity* Hsiao-yen Peng, 2015-01-28 This book views the Neo Sensation mode of writing as a traveling genre or style that originated in France moved on to Japan and then to China The author contends that modernity is possible only on the transcultural site transcultural in the sense of breaking the divide between past and present elite and popular national and regional male and female literary and non literary inside and outside To illustrate the concept of transcultural modernity three icons are highlighted on the transcultural site the dandy the flaneur and the translator Mere flaneurs and flaneurses simply float with the tide of heterogeneous information on the transcultural site whereas the dandy flaneur and the cultural translator propellers of modernity manage to bring about transformative creation Their performance
