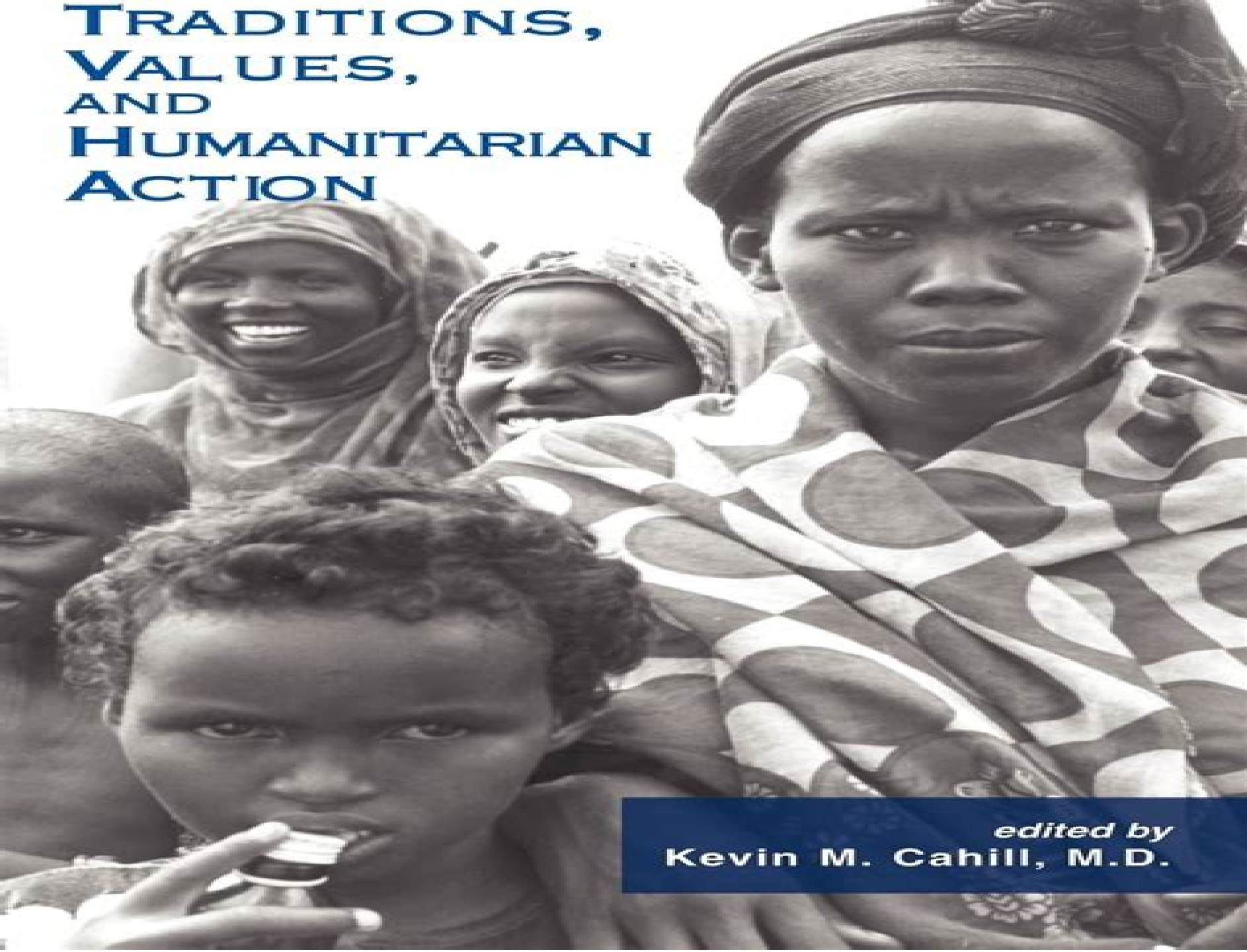

on Cluster Munitions 2008 and the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons 2017 as a paradigm shift from an older traditional state centric approach towards a more progressive humanitarian approach It shows how humanitarian disarmament has a long and complex history which includes these treaties This book argues that the attempt to locate the birth of humanitarian disarmament in these treaties is part of the attempt to cleanse humanitarian disarmament of politics presenting humanitarianism as a morally superior discourse in disarmament However humanitarianism carries its own blind spots and has its own hegemonic leanings It may be silencing other potentially more transformative discourses
