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The Roman army is commanded by Cominius with Marcius as his deputy While Cominius takes his soldiers to meet Aufidius army Marcius leads a rally against the Volscian city of Corioli The siege of Corioli is initially unsuccessful but Marcius is able to force open the gates of the city and the Romans conquer it Even though he is exhausted from the fighting Marcius marches quickly to join Cominius and fight the other Volscian force Marcius and Aufidius meet in single combat which only ends when Aufidius own soldiers drag him away from the battle In recognition of his great courage Cominius gives Caius Marcius the agnomen or official nickname of Coriolanus When they return to Rome Coriolanus s mother Volumnia encourages her son to run for consul Coriolanus is hesitant to do this but he bows to his mother s wishes He effortlessly wins the support of the Roman Senate and seems at first to have won over the commoners as well However Brutus and Sicinius scheme to undo Coriolanus and whip up another riot in opposition to his becoming consul Faced with this opposition Coriolanus flies into a rage and rails against the concept of popular rule He compares allowing plebeians to have power over the patricians to allowing crows to peck the eagles The two tribunes condemn Coriolanus as a traitor for his words and order him to be banished Coriolanus retorts that it is he who banishes Rome from his presence Coriolanus Illustrated William Shakespeare,2021-05-31 Coriolanus is a tragedy by William Shakespeare believed to have been written between 1605 and 1608 The play is based on the life of the legendary Roman leader Caius Marcius Coriolanus The tragedy is one of the last two tragedies written by Shakespeare along with Antony and Cleopatra Coriolanus is the name given to a Roman general after his military success against various uprisings challenging the government of Rome Following this success Coriolanus becomes active in politics and seeks political leadership His temperament is unsuited for popular leadership and he is quickly deposed whereupon he aligns himself to set matters straight according to his own will The alliances he forges along the way result in his ultimate downfall Shakespeare's Tragedy of Coriolanus William Shakespeare, Henry Norman Hudson, 1900

wood dealer John Aubrey 1626 1697 tells in Brief Lives that Shakespeare's father was a butcher and the young William exercised his father's trade but when he killed a Calfe he would do it in a high style and make a speech In 1568 John Shakespeare was made a mayor of Stratford and a justice of peace His wool business failed in the 1570s and in 1580 he was fined 40 with other 140 men for failing to find surety to keep the peace There is not record that his fine was paid Later the church commissioners reported of him and eight other men that they had failed to attend church for fear of process for debt The family's position was restored in the 1590s by earnings of William Shakespeare and in 1596 he was awarded a coat of arms Order today and admire the beautiful story of Coriolanus Coriolanus; Or, The Roman Matron William Shakespeare, Thomas Sheridan, 1789

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
