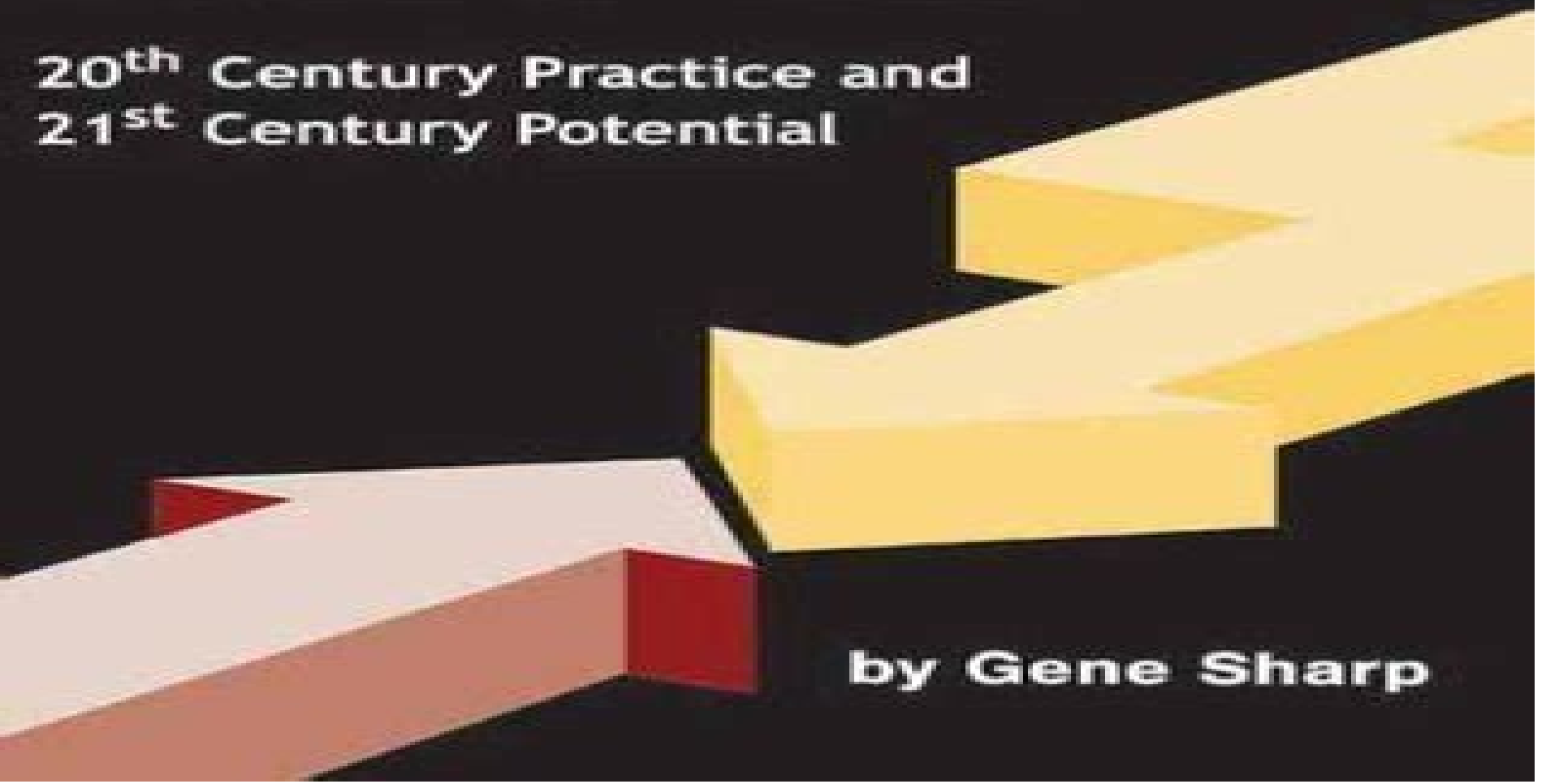

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Nonviolence in Political Theory Ian Attack, 2012-07-30 Develops a coherent theory of nonviolent political action in the context of Western political theory Ian Attack identifies the contribution of nonviolence to political theory through connecting central characteristics of nonviolent action to fundamental debates about the role of power and violence in politics This in turn provides a platform for going beyond historical and strategic accounts of nonviolence to a deeper understanding of its transformative potential From Mahatma Gandhi and Martin Luther King to toppled communist regimes in Eastern Europe and pro democracy movements in Serbia Georgia and Ukraine nonviolent action has played a significant role in achieving social and political change in the last century The Arab Spring revolutions particularly those in Tunisia and Egypt and the Occupy movement in the US and UK demonstrate that nonviolence continues to be a vital feature of many campaigns for democracy human rights and social justice

Ibadan Journal of Peace and Development, 2012 Peace Research, 2008 Both Swords and Ploughshares Linda Martz, Ineke Bockting, 2015 This collection of essays examines interactions of war peace and religion in the United States a country where religious faith was and still is often deeply felt and widely held where faith has provided a set of values to uphold with fervor or to transgress in protest and where religion has been used to legitimize both armed violence and passive resistance These essays analyze the mythos of America as a place of religious freedom yet one imbued with a socially imposed civil religion and underpinned by a heavy presumption of Protestant dominance With subjects ranging from the War of Independence to the early 21st century the contributions to this volume focus on a variety of historical and chronological circumstances in order to consider what concrete tangible outcomes what artifacts were produced by the interface of war peace and religion the swords and ploughshares of the title This volume thus presents a variety of often multifaceted responses that reflect its interdisciplinary scope Some contributions refer to fine art pieces including statues paintings and murals and others to works of literature theology or public speaking Some of these interfaces were performed on stage or in film while yet others were heard on the radio or read in newspapers or journals Some of the essays gathered here concern individuals working through the meaning of armed conflict in terms of their own personal faith while others examine the impact of such conflicts on a larger scale as with whole faith communities or in the shaping of national or foreign policy The first part *Communities* looks at interfaces that served to structure a whole community The second *Margins* examines instances where the relationship between religion and war and peace has occupied a more marginal space within a faith community The final section turns this interface Outward situating it away from American soil or noting how foreign war shaped the spirituality of those returning
