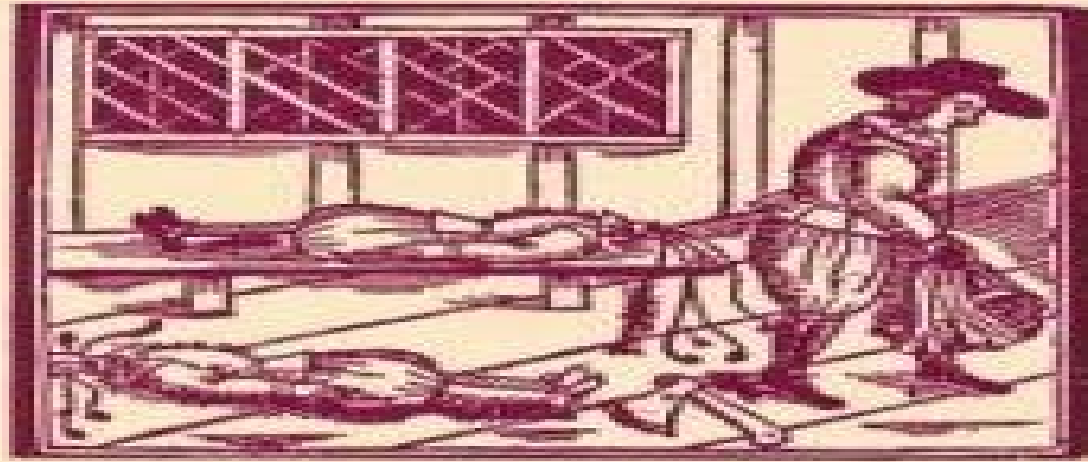

This dictionary illustrates how far from being isolated a mythological reference may resonate with the poetics of the text and its structure, cast light on characters and contexts, and may therefore be worth exploring onstage in a variety of ways. The 200 headings correspond to words and names actually used by Shakespeare: individual figures (Dido, Venus, Hercules), categories (Amazons, Centaurs, nymphs, satyrs), places (Colchis, Troy, Medea), and longer entries also cover early modern usage and critical analysis in a cross-disciplinary approach that includes reception, textual performance, gender, and political studies.
