Alvin Eng, 1999 This companion book to the Asian American Writers Workshop's *The NuyorAsian Anthology* Asian American Writings on New York City presents a collection of plays and performance pieces chronicling the struggles of the Asian American artists to find a place in the off Broadway theater world ***Choreographing Asian America*** Yutian Wong, 2011-07-21 Poised at the intersection of Asian American studies and dance studies *Choreographing Asian America* is the first book length examination of the role of Orientalist discourse in shaping Asian Americanist entanglements with U S modern dance history Moving beyond the acknowledgement that modern dance has its roots in Orientalist appropriation Yutian Wong considers the effect that invisible Orientalism has on the reception of work by Asian American choreographers and the conceptualization of Asian American performance as a category Drawing on ethnographic and choreographic research methods the author follows the work of Club O Noodles a Vietnamese American performance ensemble to understand how Asian American artists respond to competing narratives of representation aesthetics and social activism that often frame the production of Asian American performance ***Asian American Playwrights*** Miles Liu, 2002-05-30 In the late nineteenth century Asian American drama made its debut with the spotlight firmly on the lives and struggles of Asians in North America rather than on the cultures and traditions of the Asian homeland Today Asian American playwrights continue to challenge the limitations of established theatrical conventions and direct popular attention toward issues and experiences that might otherwise be ignored or marginalized While Asian American literature came into full bloom in the last 25 years Asian American drama has yet to receive the kind of critical attention it warrants This reference book serves as a versatile vehicle for exploring the field of Asian American drama from its recorded conception to its present stage Included are alphabetically arranged entries for 52 Asian American dramatists of origins from India Pakistan Vietnam the Philippines Japan Korea and China Each entry includes relevant biographical information that contextualizes the works of a playwright an interpretive description of selected plays that spotlights recurring themes and plots a summary of the playwright's critical reception and a bibliography of primary and secondary works The entries are written by expert contributors and reflect the ethnic diversity of the Asian American community The volume closes with a selected general bibliography which includes anthologies scholarly studies and periodicals ***The Greenwood Encyclopedia of Asian American Literature*** Guiyou Huang, 2008-12-30 Asian American literature dates back to the close of the 19th century and during the years following World War II it significantly expanded in volume and diversity Monumental in scope this encyclopedia surveys Asian American literature from its origins through 2007 Included are more than 270 alphabetically arranged entries on writers major works significant historical events and important terms and concepts Thus the encyclopedia gives special attention to the historical social cultural and legal contexts surrounding Asian American literature and central to the Asian American experience Each entry is written by an expert contributor and cites works for further reading and the encyclopedia closes

NYC like most of the world was in the throes of regenerating itself in the wake of major social and cultural changes resulting from the counterculture and civil rights movements And by the 1980s Flushing had become NYC's second Chinatown But Eng remained one of the neighborhood's few Chinese citizens who did not speak fluent Chinese Finding his way in the downtown theater and performance world of Manhattan he discovered the under chronicled Chinese influence on Thornton Wilder's foundational Americana drama *Our Town* This discovery became the unlikely catalyst for a psyche healing pilgrimage to Hong Kong and Guangzhou China his ancestral home in southern China that led to writing and performing his successful autobiographical monologue *The Last Emperor of Flushing* Learning to tell his own story on stages around the world was what proudly made him whole As cities classrooms cultures and communities the world over continue to re-examine the parameters of diversity equity and inclusion *Our Laundry Our Town* will reverberate with a broad readership
