composer Richard Danielpour photographer Timothy Greenfield Sanders the first published interview with Morrison's friends from Howard University Florence Ladd and Mary Wilburn and commentary from President Barack Obama What distinguishes this book from the many other publications that engage Morrison's work is that the collection is not exclusively a work of critical interpretation or reference This is the first publication to contextualize and to consider the interdisciplinary artistic and intellectual impacts of Toni Morrison using the formal fluidity and dynamism that characterize her work This book adopts Morrison's metaphor as articulated in her Pulitzer Prize winning novel *Beloved* The narrative describes the clearing as a wide open place cut deep in the woods nobody knew for what In the heat of every Saturday afternoon she sat in the clearing while the people waited among the trees Morrison's Clearing is a complicated and dynamic space Like the intricacies of Morrison's intellectual and artistic voyages the Clearing is both verdant and deadly a sanctuary and a prison Morrison's vision invites consideration of these complexities and confronts these most basic human conundrums with courage resolve and grace This collection attempts to reproduce the character and spirit of this metaphorical terrain Prophets of the Posthuman

Christina Bieber Lake, 2013-09-30 *Prophets of the Posthuman* provides a fresh and original reading of fictional narratives that raise the question of what it means to be human in the face of rapidly developing bioenhancement technologies Christina Bieber Lake argues that works by Nathaniel Hawthorne Walker Percy Flannery O'Connor Toni Morrison George Saunders Marilynne Robinson Raymond Carver James Tiptree Jr and Margaret Atwood must be reevaluated in light of their contributions to larger ethical questions Drawing on a wide range of sources in philosophical and theological ethics Lake claims that these writers share a commitment to maintaining a category of personhood more meaningful than that allowed by utilitarian ethics *Prophets of the Posthuman* insists that because technology can never ask whether we should do something that we have the power to do literature must step into that role Each of the chapters of this interdisciplinary study sets up a typical ethical scenario regarding human enhancement technology and then illustrates how a work of fiction uniquely speaks to that scenario exposing a realm of human motivations that might otherwise be overlooked or simplified Through the vision of the writers she discusses Lake uncovers a deep critique of the ascendancy of personal autonomy as America's most cherished value This ascendancy coupled with technology's glamorous promises of happiness helps to shape a utilitarian view of persons that makes responsible ethical behavior toward one another almost impossible *Prophets of the Posthuman* charts the essential role that literature must play in the continuing conversation of what it means to be human in a posthuman world

find so appealing and horrifying Are we all just gossips or is there something more to it What are the implications of our reliance on this bizarre dynamic for publicity subjectivity and democracy Literature and the Rise of the Interview addresses these questions from the perspective of literary culture The book traces the ways in which the interview form has been conceived and deployed by writers and interviewing has been understood as a literary critical practice It excavates what we might call a poetics of the interview form and practice In so doing it covers 150 years and four continents It includes a diverse rostrum of well known writers such as Henry James T S Eliot Ezra Pound Djuna Barnes William Burroughs Philip Roth J M Coetzee and Toni Morrison while reintroducing some individuals that history has forgotten such as Betty Ross Queen of Interviewers and Julian Hawthorne Nathaniel s profligate son Together these stories expose the interview s position in the literary imagination and consider what this might tell us about conceptions of literature authorship and reading communities in modernity

Philanthropy in Toni Morrison's Oeuvre Rico Hollmach,2018-11-07 This book examines Toni Morrison s highly influential works through the lens of philanthropy The point of departure of this endeavor is the keen observation that philanthropy has always played a leading role in US discourses about the nation itself While doing so time and again philanthropy has also been used as a means of social stratification especially for so called social minorities such as the African American community whose historical experience within the United States is at the very heart of Morrison s novels This book pursues the goal of a twofold understanding on the one hand through offering a rather innovative access to Morrison s works the project allows for new insights into one of today s most influential authors On the other hand this book explores the productivity of the concept of philanthropy for literary and cultural studies a concept hitherto largely neglected by scholars in both academic fields

African American Servitude and Historical Imaginings M. Jordan,2004-08-20 In African American Servitude and Historical Imaginings Margaret Jordan initiates a new way of looking at the African American presence in American literature Twentieth century retrospective fiction is the site for this compelling investigation about how African American servants and slaves have enormous utility as cultural artifacts objects to be acted upon agents in place or agents

provocateurs Jordan argues that those who even those seemingly innocuous infrequently visible or silent servants are vehicles through which history culture and social values and practices are cultivated and perpetuated challenged and destabilized Jordan demonstrates how African American servants and servitude are strategically deployed and engaged in ways which encourage a rethinking of the past She examines the ideological underpinnings of retrospective fiction by writers who are clearly social theorists and philosophers Jordan contends that they do not read or misread history they imagine history as meditations on social realities and reconstruct the past as a way to confront the present

Toni Morrison Jill L. Matus,1998-09-15 This is an illuminating and original introduction to Toni Morrison's fiction focusing on its engagement with African American history and the way the traumas of the collective past shape Morrison's work Jill Matus approaches Morrison's fiction as a form of cultural memory concerned with obscured or erased history She argues that Morrison sees African American history from the times of slavery to the continued racial oppressions of the twentieth century as a history of traumatic experience and explores how this powerful storyteller bears witness to a painful yet richly enlivening past Morrison's novels are known for their great lyric power but they often dwell on scenes of horror and Matus emphasizes the uneasy relations of memory pain and pleasure in literature In doing so she sheds new light on Morrison as a contemporary writer working at a time when literature is being urgently explored for its capacity to memorialize and testify Direct and accessible this critical study highlights the political and historical contexts of Morrison's work offers close readings of each of the novels and concludes with a critical overview of the field of Morrison studies
