The Propriety of Liberty Duncan Kelly, 2010-10-18 In this book Duncan Kelly excavates from the history of modern political thought a largely forgotten claim about liberty as a form of propriety By rethinking the intellectual and historical foundations of modern accounts of freedom he brings into focus how this major vision of liberty developed between the seventeenth and the nineteenth centuries In his framework celebrated political writers including John Locke Montesquieu Adam Smith John Stuart Mill and Thomas Hill Green pursue the claim that freedom is best understood as a form of responsible agency or propriety and they do so by reconciling key moral and philosophical claims with classical and contemporary political theory Their approach broadly assumes that only those persons who appropriately regulate their conduct can be thought of as free and responsible At the same time however they recognize that such internal forms of self propriety must be judged within the wider context of social and political life Kelly shows how the intellectual and practical demands of such a synthesis require these great writers to consider freedom as part of a broader set of arguments about the nature of personhood the potentially irrational impact of the passions and the obstinate problems of individual and political judgement By exploring these relationships *The Propriety of Liberty* not only revises the intellectual history of modern political thought but also sheds light on contemporary debates about freedom and agency

Before Utopia Ross Dealy, 2020-02-24 Before Utopia demonstrates

that Thomas More's *Utopia* 1516 is not as widely accepted a rhetorical play of spirit but is instead built from a particular philosophy. That philosophy is not Platonism but classical Stoicism. Deeply disturbed in his youth by the conviction that he needed to decide between a worldly and a monastic path, Thomas More was transformed in 1504 by Erasmus De *taedio Iesu* and *Enchiridion*. As a consequence, he married in 1505 and wholeheartedly committed himself to worldly affairs. His *Lucian* 1506, written after working directly with Erasmus, adopts the Stoic mindset. Erasmus' *Praise of Folly* 1511 shows from beginning to end the workings of More's life-changing Stoic outlook. More's *Utopia* then goes on to systematically illustrate the Stoic unitary two-dimensional frame of thought within an imaginary New World setting. Before *Utopia* is not just a book about Thomas More; it is a book about intellectual history and the movement of ideas from the ancient world to the Renaissance. Ross Dealy emphasizes the continuity between Erasmus and More in their religious and philosophical thought and above all the decisive influence of Erasmus on More.

Popular Sovereignty in Early Modern Constitutional Thought Daniel Lee, 2016. Popular sovereignty, the doctrine that the public powers of state originate in a concessive grant of power from the people, is perhaps the cardinal doctrine of modern constitutional theory, placing full constitutional authority in the

people at large rather than in the hands of judges kings or a political elite Although its classic formulation is to be found in the major theoretical treatments of the modern state such as in the treatises of Hobbes Locke and Rousseau this book explores the intellectual origins of this doctrine and investigates its chief source in late medieval and early modern thought Long regarded the principal source for modern legal reasoning Roman law had a profound impact on the major architects of popular sovereignty such as Francois Hotman Jean Bodin and Hugo Grotius Adopting the juridical language of obligations property and personality as well as the model of the Roman constitution these jurists crafted a uniform theory that located the right of sovereignty in the people at large as the legal owners of state authority In recovering the origins of popular sovereignty the book demonstrates the importance of the Roman law as a chief source of modern constitutional thought

Sposato, 2022-03-15 In *Forged in the Shadow of Mars* Peter W Sposato traces chivalry's powerful influence

on the mentality and behavior of a sizeable segment of the elite in late medieval Florence He finds that the strenuous knights and men at arms of the Florentine chivalric elite a cultural community comprised of men from both traditional and newly emerged elite lineages embraced a chivalric ideology that was fundamentally martial and violent Chivalry helped to shape a common identity among these men based on the profession of arms and the ready use of violence against both their peers and those they perceived to be their social inferiors This violence often transgressive in nature was not only crucial to asserting and defending personal familial and corporate honor but was also inherently praiseworthy In this way Sposato highlights the sharp differences between chivalry and the more familiar civic ideology of the popolo grasso the Florentine mercantile and banking elite who came to dominate Florence politically and economically during the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries As a result in *Forged in the Shadow of Mars* Sposato challenges the traditional scholarly view of chivalry as foreign to the social and cultural landscape of Florence and contests its reputation as a civilizing force By reexamining the connection between chivalric literature and actual practice and identity formation among historical knights and men at arms he likewise provides an important corrective to assumptions about the nature of elite violence and identity in medieval Italian cities

Common: The Development of Literary Culture in Sixteenth-Century England Neil Rhodes, 2018-04-13 This volume explores the development of literary culture in sixteenth century England as a whole and seeks to explain the relationship between the Reformation and the literary renaissance of the Elizabethan period Its central theme is the common in its double sense of something shared and something base and it argues that making common the work of God is at the heart of the English Reformation just as making common the literature of antiquity and of early modern Europe is at the heart of the English Renaissance Its central question is why was the Renaissance in England so late That question is addressed in terms of the relationship between Humanism and Protestantism and the tensions between democracy and the imagination which persist throughout the century Part One establishes a social dimension for literary culture in the period by exploring the associations of commonwealth and related terms It addresses the role of Greek in the period before and during the Reformation in disturbing the old binary of elite Latin and common English It also argues that the Reformation principle of making common is coupled with a hostility towards fiction which has the effect of closing down the humanist renaissance of the earlier decades Part Two presents translation as the link between Reformation and Renaissance and the final part discusses the Elizabethan literary renaissance and deals in turn with poetry short prose fiction and the drama written for the common stage
