It can be modified in various ways to fit the individual's needs and challenges many other cognitive and visual-perceptual skills such

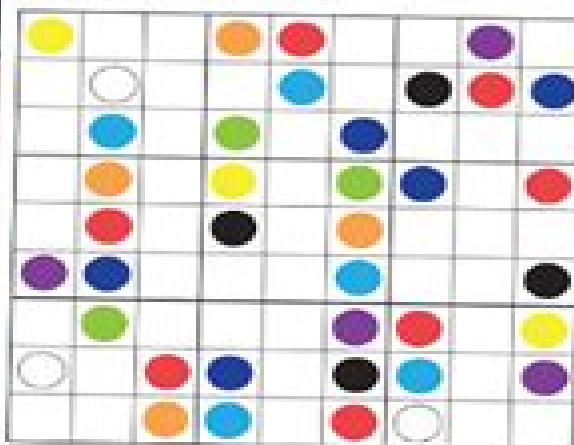
OPTIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS ACTIVITY

- Incorporate visual aid(s) or memory strategies into the task to upgrade/downgrade a task as needed.
- Attach the activity onto a wall to address gross motor coordination, maximize

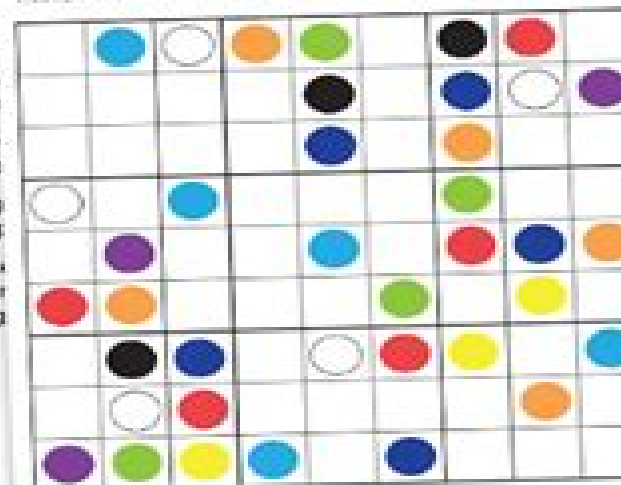
