Philips, 1987-06-26 Most studies of gender differences in language use have been undertaken from exclusively either a sociocultural or a biological perspective By contrast this innovative volume places the analysis of language and gender in the context of a biocultural framework examining both cultural and biological sources of gender differences in language as well as the interaction between them The first two parts of the volume on cultural variation in gender differentiated language use comparing Western English speaking societies with societies elsewhere in the world The essays are distinguished by an emphasis on the syntax rather than style or strategy of gender differentiated forms of discourse but also often carry out the same forms differently through different choices of language form These gender differences are shown to be socially organized although the essays in Part I also raise the possibility that some cross cultural similarities in the ways males and females differentially use language may be related to sex based differences in physical and emotional makeup Part III examines the relationship between language and the brain and shows that although there are differences between the ways males and females process language in the brain these do not yield any differences in linguistic competence or language use Taken as a whole the essays reveal a great diversity in the cultural construction of gender through language and explicitly show that while there is some evidence of the influence of biologically based sex differences on the language of women and men the influence of culture is far greater and gender differences in language use are better accounted for in terms of culture than in terms of biology The collection will appeal widely to anthropologists psychologists linguists and other concerned with the understanding of gender roles

though the differences between the genders when it comes to the wording of apologies are not clear cut there are certain tendencies which are interesting to look at. These sociolinguistic differences mainly come from the high correlation between the use of language of a person and their social background, society norms, standards and expectations on gender behaviourism. The question if real language differences exist between the genders needs further consideration because it also depends on the individual and the context. In this essay the author focuses on people who have a certain media presence i.e. on YouTube and reach a large young audience. They have to choose their words very carefully in order to retain and/or regain a positive image and to reduce the danger of losing their followers. Just by examining a certain limited number of different sources it becomes clear that women and men not only regard and react to apologies differently but also use them in different proportions and for different purposes.

Chapter 1 defines the difference between gender and sex and explains what is meant by the study of language and gender. Johnson, 1995 The relationship between gender group identity and variation in usage of the Berlin Urban Vernacular (BUV) is explored with particular reference to feminist critiques of sociolinguistic research The study is based on a network of native Berliners referred to as the Berlin group Friendship ties and activities within the group are explored qualitatively and the findings quantified in the form of a Group Identity Score (GIS) allocated to each informant The linguistic corpus is then analyzed in terms of potential correlation between gender GIS and variation in usage of phonological variables of the BUV Though some differences emerge in the way men and women appear to use the BUV in order to identify with the group no differences are found in the actual quantity of dialectal variants used by men and women The study provides an appraisal of the sociolinguistic methods normally applied in variationist work and questions the uncritical pursuit of sex difference especially where similarity is potentially of equal if not greater relevance

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
