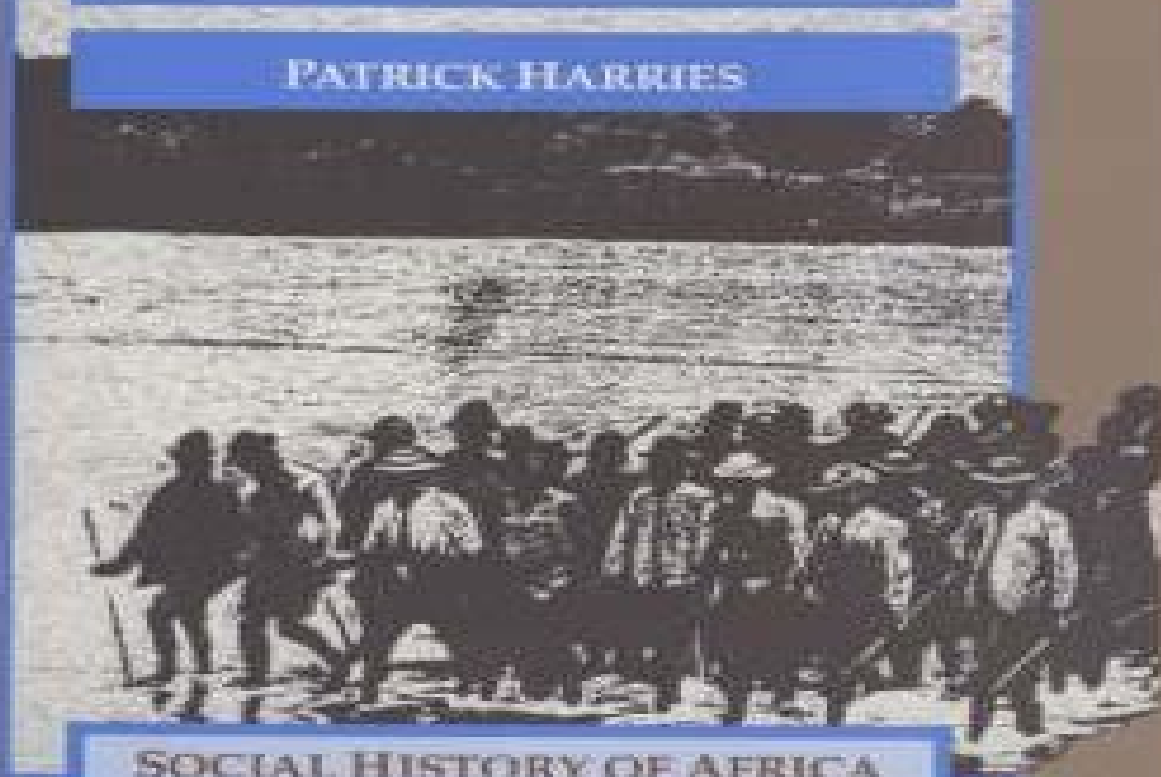

Hassan, 2008 This book provides a forum for intellectual exchange around the connections between nationalism and power in Africa with Africa viewed as a global presence Various chapters explore aspects of the colonial order the nature of change and of agencies within a comparative perspective Power and Nationalism in Modern Africa also interrogates African modernity and how it is constructed and articulated in comparison to other modernities The chapters move from localism to globalism and through various ideas and analyses we see modern Africa in a nuanced manner a continent that is capable of accepting other cultures and traditions without losing all of its indigenous beliefs and values The book exposes the power of traditions to reshape history creating in different parts of the African diaspora the ideas to redefine lives and spaces and struggles to create a new future Africans like others have their own ideas and constructions of modernity and modernism They have as the various contributions to this volume have amply demonstrated staged modernity on their own terms and in the process recast it in their own image **The International Journal of African Historical Studies**, 2000 Militant Migrants Henry Dee, 2025-11-11 Born in colonial Malawi Clements Kadalie dramatically rose to global prominence as general secretary of the Industrial and Commercial Workers Union of Africa ICU during the 1920s A famed orator journalist and trade union organiser Kadalie electrified huge meetings with his call for economic freedom and all in mass organisation eclipsing nationalist contemporaries and unionising anywhere between 100 000 and 250 000 workers throughout South Africa Namibia Lesotho and Zimbabwe A global labour history of Southern Africa from the perspective of the ICU s immigrant leadership Militant Migrants rehabilitates the significance of the early Malawian diaspora the global importance of Kadalie s ideas the rationale behind the ICU s transnational organising and the many awkward difficulties that Kadalie faced in his personal life Although the ICU dramatically collapsed during the early 1930s Kadalie s fall from grace encapsulates a broader turning point in Southern African history offering unique insights into ideas of gender nation and family that he and other

immigrants challenged Leaving a complicated legacy of unprecedented successes and inescapable failures Kadalie s life remains a compelling and necessary tale of audacity solidarity and militant mass struggle not least of all because of the profound challenges that he faced

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World War II has long been acknowledged as a watershed in modern history of Africa yet there are few books that examine the years of the war in a particular African country This book helps to fill this gap by analysing the wartime mobilisation of settlers soldiers and labourers in colonial Zimbabwe It examines the sacrifices demanded of ten of thousands of Africans who were coerced into settler production as their contribution to the British war effort Africans did not remain passive in the face of this onslaught and the book also addresses their efforts to make their own history especially on relation to the post war rebellions of 1945 and 1948

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
