

workers who effectively served as references for employment They worked for contractual periods of between six months and five years for which they were paid wages The Kru thereby stand out as an anomaly in the history of Atlantic trade when compared with the much larger diasporas of enslaved Africans Migration, Mining, and the African Diaspora B.
