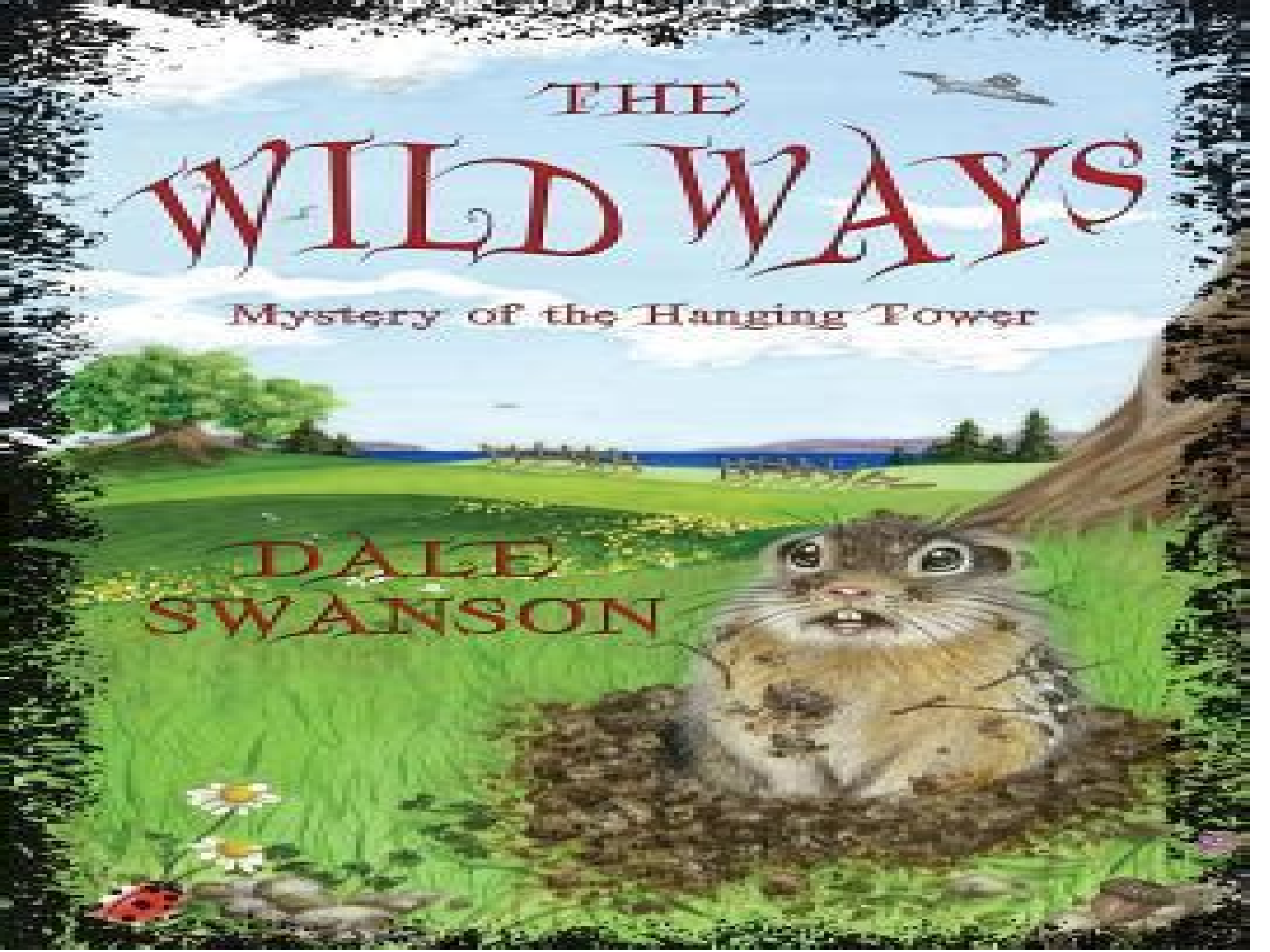

Later literary works included the *Professor Challenger* series, which began with *The Lost World*, in which Challenger sets out to find evidence of prehistoric life. The book inspired numerous adaptations, including the films *Jurassic Park* and *The Lost World*. In later life, Doyle became captivated by the world of spiritualism and the occult and published non-fiction works about his beliefs, including *The Coming of the Fairies*. Arthur Conan Doyle died at home in 1930.
