about 1 000 allegedly gay men The primary message in OK2BG is to read reassess before you run asunder *Affairs of the Art* Katrina Strickland,2013-05-01 The reputations of artists are curious things influenced by factors beyond the quality of the work *Affairs of the Art* explores the role those left behind play in burnishing an artist s reputation after he or she dies Through interviews with those handling the estates of artists including Fred Williams Brett Whiteley John Brack Howard Arkley Bronwyn Oliver George Baldessin and Albert Tucker as well as a raft of art dealers academics curators and auctioneers Strickland traverses the strange alleyways of the art market where power resides with those who hold the best stock and highlights the sometimes heart wrenching way emotion and duty intersect in the making of decisions by those left behind
