The Diary of Nannie Haskins Williams Minoa D. Uffelman, Ellen Kanervo, Eleanor Williams, Smith Phyllis, 2014-04-30 In 1863 while living in Clarksville Tennessee Martha Ann Haskins known to friends and family as Nannie began a diary The Diary of Nannie Haskins Williams A Southern Woman's Story of Rebellion and Reconstruction 1863 1890 provides valuable insights into the conditions in occupied Middle Tennessee A young elite Confederate sympathizer Nannie was on the cusp of adulthood with the expectation of becoming a mistress in a slaveholding society The war ended this prospect and her life was forever changed Though this is the first time the diaries have been published in full they are well known among Civil War scholars and a voice over from the wartime diary was used repeatedly in Ken Burns's famous PBS program The Civil War Sixteen year old Nannie had to come to terms with Union occupation very early in the war Amid school assignments young friendship social events worries about her marital prospects and tension with her mother Nannie's entries also mixed information about battles neighbors wounded in combat U S Colored troops and lawlessness in the surrounding countryside Providing rare detail about daily life in an occupied city Nannie's diary poignantly recounts how she and those around her continued to fight long after the war was over not in battles but to maintain their lives in a war torn community Though numerous women's Civil War diaries exist Nannie's is unique in that she also recounts her postwar life and the unexpected financial struggles she and her family experienced in the post Reconstruction South Nannie's diary may record only one woman's experience but she represents a generation of young women born into a society based on slavery but who faced mature adulthood in an entirely new world of decreasing farm values increasing industrialization and young women entering the workforce Civil War scholars and students alike will learn much from this firsthand account of coming of age during the Civil War Minoa D Uffelman is an associate professor of history at Austin Peay State University Ellen Kanervo is professor emerita of communications at Austin Peay State University Phyllis Smith is retired from the U S Army and currently teaches high school science in Montgomery County Tennessee Eleanor Williams is the Montgomery County Tennessee historian

Lorence,2007 *A Hard Journey* brings to life Don West poet ordained Congregationalist minister labour organizer educator leftist radical activist and one of the most important literary and political figures in the southern Appalachians during the middle years of the twentieth century Motivated by religious conviction and driven by a vision of an open democratic and non racist society West was also a

passionate advocate for the region's traditional values. Rather than focus on his literary achievements alone, James J. Lorence's biography balances his literary work with political and educational activities, placing West's poetry in the context of his fight for social justice and racial equality. From the Mountains to the Bay

From January to July of 1862, the armies and navies of the Union and Confederacy conducted an incredibly complex and remarkably diverse range of operations in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Under the direction of leaders like Thomas Stonewall Jackson, George McClellan, Joseph E. Johnston, John Rodgers, Robert E. Lee, Franklin Buchanan, Irvin McDowell, and Louis M. Goldsborough, men of the Union and Confederate armed forces marched over mountains and through shallow valleys, maneuvered on and along great tidal rivers, bridged and waded their tributaries, battled malarial swamps, dug trenches, and constructed fortifications, and advanced and retreated in search of operational and tactical advantage. In the course of these operations, the North demonstrated it had learned quite a bit from its setbacks of 1861 and was able to achieve significant operational and tactical success on both land and sea. This enabled Union arms to bring a considerable portion of Virginia under Federal control in some cases temporarily and in others permanently. Indeed, at points during the spring and early summer of 1862, it appeared the North just might succeed in bringing about the defeat of the rebellion before the year was out. *A sweeping study of the operations on land and sea, From the Mountains to the Bay* is the only modern scholarly work that looks at the operations that took place in Virginia in early 1862, from the Romney Campaign that opened the year to the naval engagement between the *Monitor* and *Merrimack* to the movements and
