O'Keefe, 1995 Pope John Paul II's encyclical *Veritatis Splendor* is an historic document the first extensive analysis of the foundations of morality by a pope. It stands alongside the new catechism as a major statement about Christian morality, the role of reason in the moral life, and the vision of life for the disciple of Jesus.

The Concept of Intrinsic Evil and Catholic Theological Ethics Nenad Polgar, Joseph A. Selling, 2019-04-08 One of the most sweeping categorical and absolute phrases that has ever been employed by the hierarchical teaching authority of the Roman Catholic Church refers to a concept called intrinsic evil. In short, intrinsic evil is invoked to describe certain kinds of human acts that can never be morally justified or permitted regardless of the intention of the person who performs them or any circumstances within which they take place. The most common examples of things that people recognize as being classified as intrinsically evil are suicide, euthanasia, abortion, and the use of contraception. The ease with which the term intrinsic evil gets right to the point, thereby making the fairly complex field of ethical reflection seem manageable and widely accessible, is one of the reasons for its attractiveness within Roman Catholic ethical teaching. However, this kind of simplification risks or even encourages avoidance of critical questions such as: Where does this concept come from and what meanings are associated with it? Is it supposed to express an ethical judgment or to form it? and Is there a substantial difference between intrinsically evil acts and morally wrong acts? The contributors to this volume engage with these and similar issues surrounding the formation and use of the concept and, in the process, dispel the naive belief that the concept can somehow escape the complexity of ethical discourse or establish certainty of ethical judgments that is otherwise unattainable. In light of this realization, the most important issue becomes whether the concept can still be useful for Catholic theological ethics. Although the contributors to this volume do not completely agree on this issue, they have shown that a critical scrutiny of the concept must necessarily precede settling this issue and that the concept might not be able to withstand such critical judgment. The book provides a description of the origin and meanings of the concept of intrinsic evil. While the term itself tends to create confusion rather than clarity, eliminating its use does not imply that we cannot still have a meaningful discussion about things that should never be done.

The Seductiveness of Virtue John J.

Fitzgerald, 2016-12-15 John J. Fitzgerald addresses here one of life's enduring questions: how to achieve personal fulfillment and more specifically, whether we can do so through ethical conduct. He focuses on two significant twentieth-century theologians: Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel and Pope John Paul II, seeing both as fitting dialogue partners given the former's influence on the Second Vatican Council's deliberations on the Jews and the latter's groundbreaking overtures to the Jews in the wake of his experiences in Poland before and during World War II. Fitzgerald demonstrates that Heschel and John Paul II both suggest that doing good generally leads us to growth in various components of personal fulfillment, such as happiness, meaning in life, and freedom from selfish desires. There are, however, some key differences between the two theologians. John

Paul II emphasizes more strongly the relationship between acting well and attaining eternal life whereas Heschel wrestles more openly with the possibility that religious commitment ultimately involves anxiety and sadness By examining historical and contemporary analyses including the work of the Fourteenth Dalai Lama the philosopher Peter Singer and some present day psychologists Fitzgerald builds a narrative that shows the promise and limits of Heschel's and John Paul II's views

Law Tradition Christopher Kaczor, 2010 Consequentialism and Catholic ethics seem to be natural enemies The Catholic prohibition against intentionally killing the innocent lying committing adultery and so on contradicts the very essence of consequentialism that no act may be assessed as good or evil independently of its consequences However in the 1960s within the Catholic tradition itself there arose a method in ethics called proportionalism which practically if not theoretically affirmed that which consequentialists have long affirmed and Catholic ethicists had so long denied namely one may do evil that good may come According to proportionalists so long as the good effects are proportioned to the bad effects of the act the act is licit even if evil is used as a means to achieve the good In this book Christopher Kaczor argues against the plausibility of proportionalism and its first proponents namely Peter Knauer Joseph Fuchs Bruno Schüller Louis Janssens and Richard McCormick Examining the genealogy of the movement he disputes a received history that depicts proportionalism as a recovery of Thomas Aquinas Instead contends Kaczor proportionalism is best seen as the organic successor to the moral manuals of the pre Vatican II era Proportionalism arises not from Thomas but rather extends many of the tendencies and presuppositions of the manuals In particular it retains their marginalizing of the account of human action as a knowing
