have to respond to the challenges posed by problems such as BSE FMD and antimicrobial resistance All these problems require identification quantification and intensive examination of multiple directly or indirectly causal and often interacting disease determinants Veterinary epidemiology and evidence based veterinary medicine provide overlapping sets of tools which can be used to approach these new challenges
