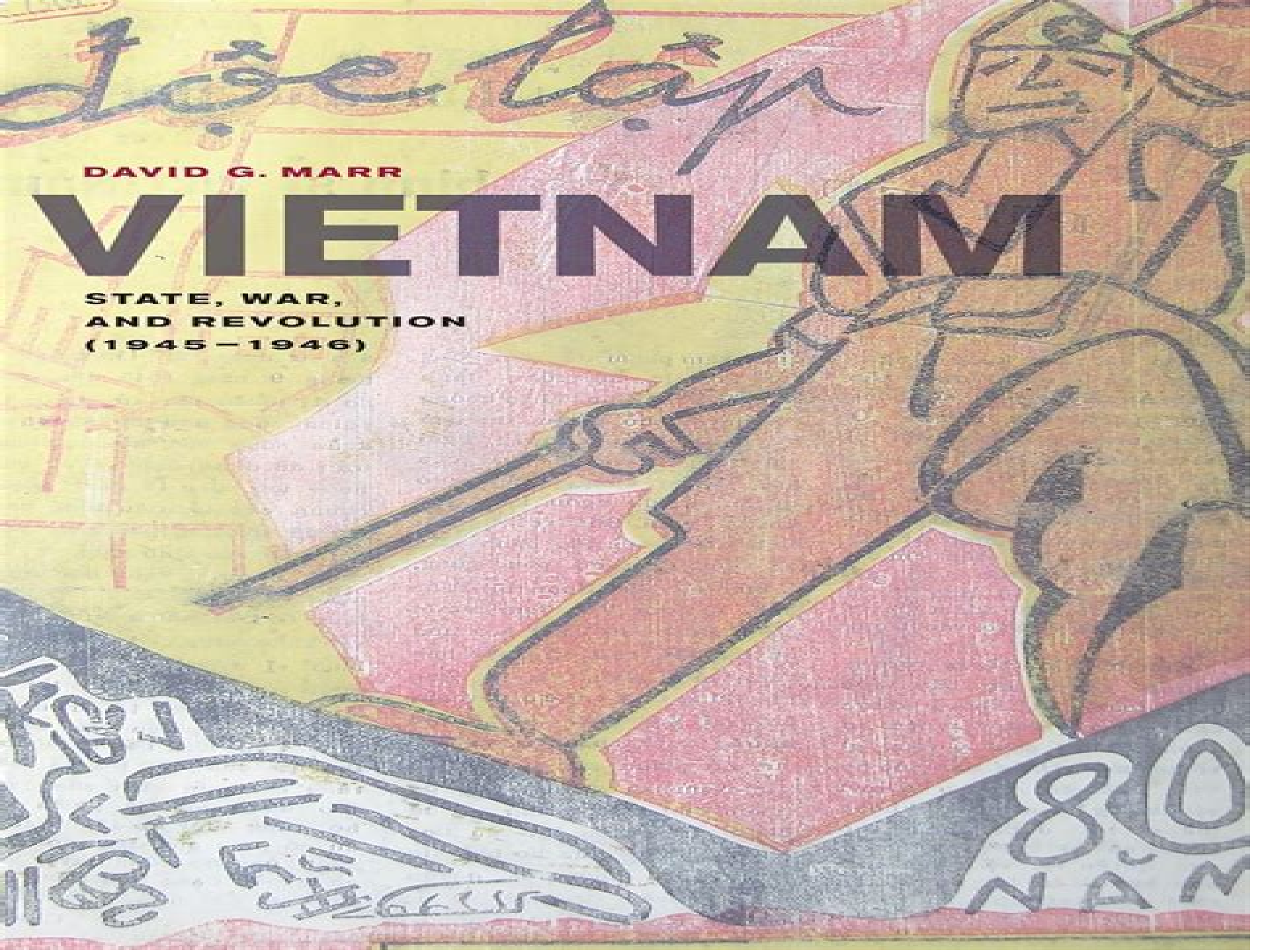

separate conflicts But Nguyen demonstrates that the evacuees experienced a continuous civil war A Displaced Nation shows the evacuees felt so validated by transnational support that they thought they could use this external help to return one day to the north This belief was not constant nor were the strategies to achieve it the same for all but through their political activism and action the evacuees showed they were willing to seize any opportunity to oppose Hanoi during the subsequent decades even once established overseas
