vagabond Vaughan Williams's setting of the poetry of Matthew Arnold and Robert Louis Stevenson as a metaphor and paradigm for his creative career and personal progress. The book not only sheds light on the activities and ambitions of principal agents but also illuminates a particularly dynamic moment in the re-emergence of a distinctively English music theatrical practice, one especially concerned with calling on aspects of the past to help to secure a worthwhile future. Notions of Englishness turn out to be less insular than sometimes thought, and the idea of a musical renaissance more complex when the case studies are understood in their proper historical context. Scholars and students of twentieth-century English music theatre and opera will find this volume indispensable. Roger Savage is Honorary Fellow in English Literature at the University of Edinburgh. Grandma Gatewood's Walk Ben Montgomery, 2014-04-01 Emma Gatewood told her family she was going on a walk and left her small Ohio hometown with a change of clothes and less than two hundred dollars The next anybody heard from her this genteel farm reared 67 year old great grandmother had walked 800 miles along the 2 050 mile Appalachian Trail By September 1955 she stood atop Maine's Mount Katahdin sang America the Beautiful and proclaimed I said I'll do it and I've done it Driven by a painful marriage Grandma Gatewood became the first woman to hike the entire Appalachian Trail alone as well as the first person man or woman to walk it twice and three times At age 71 she hiked the 2 000 mile Oregon Trail Gatewood became a hiking celebrity and appeared on TV with Groucho Marx and Art Linkletter The public attention she brought to the trail was unprecedented Her vocal criticism of the lousy difficult stretches led to bolstered maintenance and very likely saved the trail from extinction Author Ben Montgomery interviewed surviving family members and hikers Gatewood met along the trail unearthed historic newspaper and magazine articles and was given unprecedented access to Gatewood's own diaries trail journals and correspondence Grandma Gatewood's Walk shines a fresh light on one of America's most celebrated pedestrians Ben Montgomery is a staff writer at the Tampa Bay Times and co founder of the Auburn Chautauqua a Southern writers collective He was a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize in 2010 and has won many other national writing awards He lives in Florida
